New Direct Flights Make Getting to Daytona Beach is Easier than Ever

Non-stop flights being added from Toronto, New York City, Fort Lauderdale

DAYTONA BEACH, Fla. (December 20, 2019) – For those eager to escape to the sunshine state in search of beautiful beaches and warm ocean breezes, getting to Daytona Beach, Florida, is now easier than ever.

Sunwing Airlines is expanding its services to Florida to offer flights to Daytona Beach from Toronto for the first time. Sunwing is the only Canadian carrier to offer direct international flights to Daytona International Airport (DAB), which is located just five miles from the beach. **The twice weekly seasonal flight service will operate on Mondays and Thursdays beginning January 28, 2019.**

Starting January 16, Silver Airways will start offering direct flights from Fort Lauderdale to DAB, adding many new connection options to travelers.

Other airlines offering service into Daytona Beach include Delta with direct flights from Atlanta, Georgia, and **American Airlines with direct flights from Charlotte and – starting May 4 – New York City (LaGuardia).**

Located on Florida's east coast, Daytona Beach is the perfect beach base camp for experiencing authentic Florida and exploring the best of what Central Florida has to offer. Visitors driving to their destination have easy access from two interstate highways – I-95 and I-4.
