One Attraction Towers Above the Rest.



A Rich and Vibrant History

For more than a century, the Tower Tree has been central to our community's identity as a symbol of growth. This highly visible, Atlas-Obscura-worthy attraction grows at an altitude of 110 feet above the historic Courthouse lawn. Through the years, new generations of trees have sprouted up through the silt and soil in a hole in the roof of the clock tower. For more than 150 years, there has been a tree perched atop the Courthouse making it a phenomenon to behold.




