Visit **Coors Field** to catch a Rockies game, explore the **Denver Art Museum** for a dose of creative inspiration, or see a show at the **Denver Performing Arts Complex**, the largest performing arts center in the U.S. outside of New York City.

Get Ready for the New 16th Street

Denver's iconic 16th Street is undergoing a huge renovation to ensure downtown's main pedestrian thoroughfare remains a destination that Denver residents and visitors can enjoy for decades to come, including improved safety and mobility, while creating new opportunities for public use and enjoyment. Pedestrian access to stores, hotels, and restaurants remains open and accessible.

During construction, the 16th Street Free MallRide buses remain in service, running on 16th Street between Union Station and Curtis Street, then re-routing to 15th Street and 17th Street, with an abundance of signage and wayfinding along the way.

A Line Airport Train

A convenient and affordable \$10.00 day pass or one-way fare will take you by train from Denver Union Station (DUS) to Denver International Airport (DEN). Discounted tickets are available for seniors, individuals with disabilities and others. The Zero Fare for Youth program invites ages 19 and under to ride at no cost. You can purchase tickets at vending machines on rail line platforms, in the DUS underground bus concourse, or at any RTD sales outlet. To buy tickets online, use the RTD MyRide mobile app.

Taxis are readily available downtown. At Denver Union Station they are located across Wynkoop Street at 17th Street and 18th Street near the IMA Building.

Rideshares are available throughout downtown. At Denver Union Station, convenient five-minute loading zones are located on Wynkoop and Wewatta Streets for Uber, Bird, and private cars.

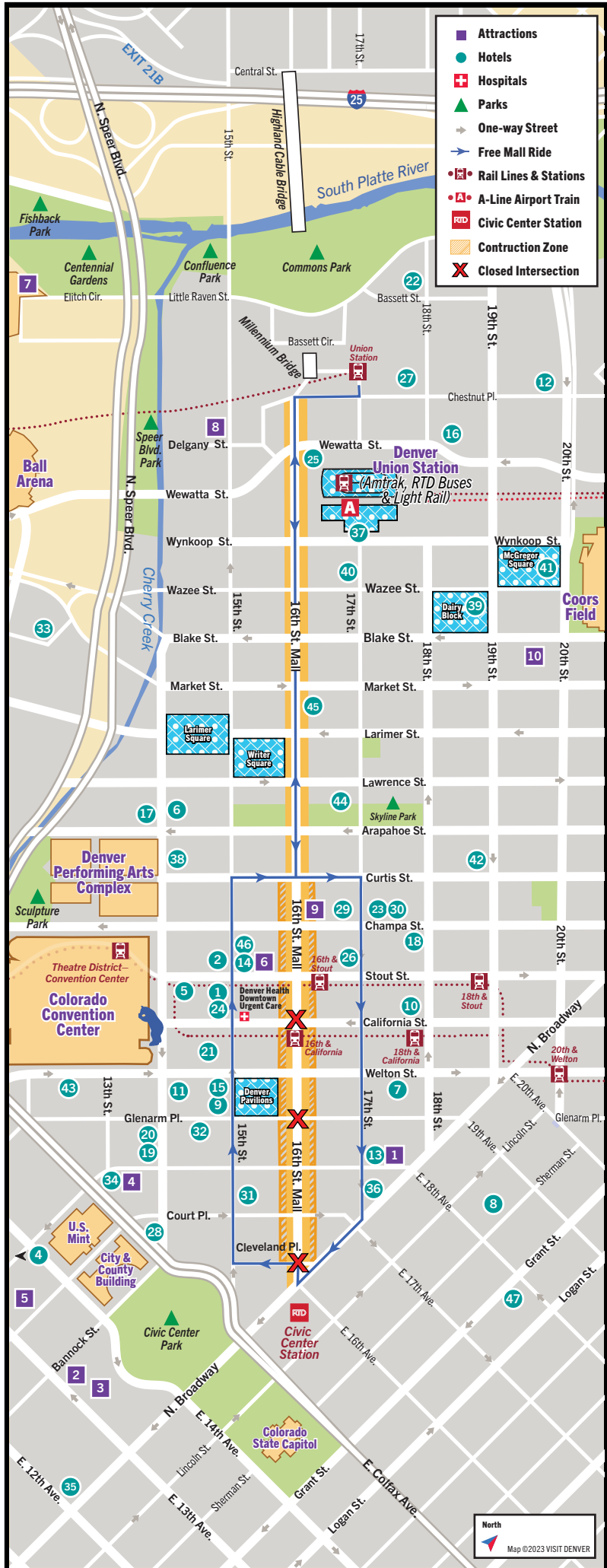
Bike-Friendly Streets
