Denver's farm-to-table dining scene is hot in places like **Larimer Square** where Victorian buildings are now home to boutique shops, wine bars and restaurants, or in historic **Denver Union Station** which has become a hotspot for innovative cuisine and old- fashioned elegance. The station is a fun gathering place for visitors to eat a breakfast burrito at Snooze, sip a beer at the Terminal Bar, sample the locally sourced cuisine at one of the



chef-owned restaurants or have a hand- mixed cocktail at Cooper Lounge.

s easy to get around the city on foot or by bike. e **16th Street Mall** is a mile-long pedestrian omenade lined with outdoor cafés and shops. ee shuttle buses stop at street corners every few inutes, providing quick access to hotels, restaurants, rs and attractions in the city center. **LoDo**, (Lower owntown), is Denver's hip historic district, where ick warehouses have been transformed into uzens of restaurants, rooftop bars and nightclubs.






ROCKY MOUNTAIN DAY TRIPS
