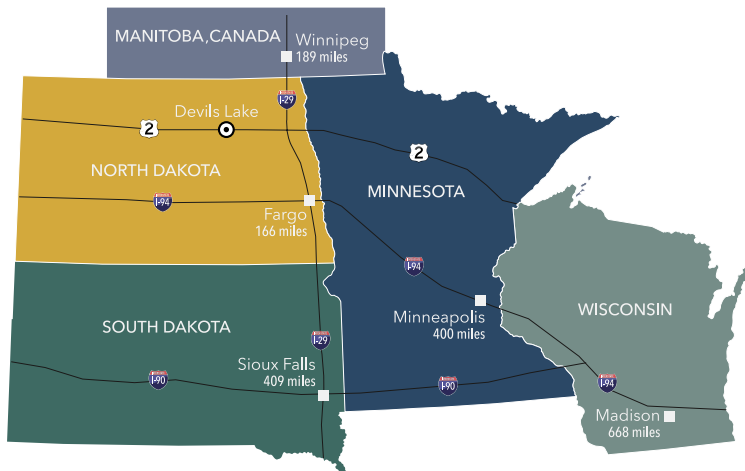

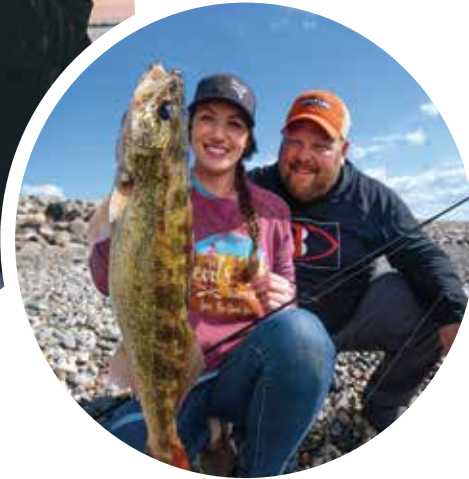

FISHING



FISHING

SEASON IS OPEN YEAR-ROUND

Nestled in North Dakota's famed wheat and grain belt lies an enormous lake known as a fish factory. Devils Lake may have created more fishing smiles than any place else in North America. It does so every day of the year since seasons are open year-round.

Open water fishing occurs from May into November when it transitions into winter ice fishing. New and regular visitors appreciate the knowledge of experienced fishing guides and guide services. Providing boats in summer or travel and shelters on ice, guides also supply the "where-to-go" hotspots, tackle, gear, bait and quickly become good friends. Warning: Visit and fish with guides once, and you will be hooked. Returning guide clients call each trip to Devils Lake a reunion.

Four species of game fish swim in the main lake and the connected lakes. With 165,000 acres currently, up from 40,000 acres 40 years ago, the growing lake caused considerable dike, road, railroad and shoreline reconstruction. In fact, the submerged roadbeds now attract walleyes. So do the rocky/gravelly original shorelines created as the water rose more

More free, public fish-cleaning stations in and around Devils Lake than anywhere else.

SERVICE WITH A SMILE IS THE ATTITUDE OF DEVILS LAKE RESIDENTS. They pooled resources with fishing clubs, state departments, conservation organizations and others to build first-class fish cleaning stations at many launch sites. These are open from spring until freeze-up. There is also a year round heated or air-conditioned cleaning station just south of Ed's Bait Shop on Hwy 20. Fish cleaning station locations: Henegar Landing, Lakewood Landing, 6 Mile Bay, Spirit Lake Casino, Grahams Island State Park, Stump Lake Park Landing, Tolna Landing. Also, many resorts and motels have their own fish cleaning houses with freezers.

Handicap Accessible, Free, Public Fishing Piers

Special fishing docks for physically impaired and elderly fishermen have been installed on Channel A (great spring walleye highway), Henegar Landing, Pikes Playground and Fishing Pier and at the Creel Bay Lakewood Beach. For directions, check the Devils Lake website.

than 30 feet. Farms, homes, barns, silos, machinery and more reside under the surface. Guides like to show clients these objects on their fish-finder electronics.

Each summer the North Dakota Fish and Game conducts fish surveys, an annual project done for the past 33 years. Last year showed a phenomenal result for walleyes. The 2024 netting results were at long-term averages. Overall, the fisheries crews discovered 22.6 walleyes per net this year. The age structure showed strong correlations to past records, with the 15 to 20 inch walleyes and the 25 to 30 inch walleyes above average.

The eastern portion of Devils Lake has a higher salinity content, which impacts egg development. To supplement that end of the lake, fisheries stocked it with 480,000 walleye fingerlings this season. Of note, Todd Caspers, regional fish manager indicated that fall brood surveys showed a very strong catch of young-of-the-year walleyes.

Perch are a favorite of the ice crowd, and survey results showed most size classes near average, with the 12 to 15 inch perch considerably above average.

WHAT ABOUT PERCH?

Devils Lake is the Number One perch ice fishing destination in North America. They are regarded as one

of the tastiest freshwater fish. Perch school. Find one, and keep working the area. Catch one and more are sure to bite. Others will be nearby. Guides follow these schools and move their clients accordingly. Guide Mark Bry said, "Perch fishing is like an addiction – the tug is the drug. People can't believe how big they grow here." Limits are 20 per day with 40 in possession.

PERCH HAVE A BIG COUSIN – WALLEYES

Walleyes are members of the perch family. Their white-tipped tails excite fishermen as they bend rods and come within sight of the net. Springtime is special as walleyes move shallow to eat and spawn. Small lures, jigs with plastic paddle tails and slip bobbers with an enticing leech below are all popular. Summer means bottom-bouncing, slip-bobbers, trolling or casting crankbaits. Fall is a bonanza as walleyes feed heavily going into winter. Come winter, guides concentrate on walleyes early and late, with perch during the day. The limit is five walleyes daily with 10 in possession.

WHITE BASS ARE FUN!

Open water or under the ice, white bass bite. They will be part of every Devils Lake fishing day. Because of the popularity of walleyes and perch, white bass are seldom

targeted. They school, and as a diversion to the day or just to have fun, catch one and stay in the vicinity to catch more. They are some of the fightingest fresh water fish, especially the 3 to 4 pounders so prevalent in the lake. Good eating, too, but when filleting, eliminate any red meat along the skin or lateral line. Get one on the line, and it will come to net when it's good and ready.

THEN, THERE'S PIKE

Pike seem to find fishermen. It's not essential to look for them, because they're everywhere some days; nowhere at other times. A few locals chase the biggest pike with their fly rods. A 51.5 inch pike with a girth of 22 inches was landed by Nathan LaFleur. He released what likely would have easily eclipsed the state record 37.5 pound pike. Pike zip, dash and go crazy on the end of a fishing line. In winter, tip-up running is a great kids' game. In spring, catch them from shore. At any other open water time, expect the unexpected when a pike says, "I want that." They're called water wolves for a reason. Respect their teeth. One of the best eating fish. Learn to fillet around bones (guides will show you) and enjoy the fight and the taste.

Devils Lake contains what every visiting fisherman wants – fish. Lots of them. And, guides who will share lessons on how to catch them. Check the listing on the Devils Lake website for a comprehensive list of guides.

ANS SURCHARGE FEES

Starting back in 2020, a surcharge will be added to certain game and watercraft licenses to support the Aquatic Nuisance Species Program Fund. All boats licensed in North Dakota will include this surcharge when renewing the license. Boats not licensed in North Dakota are required to pay an annual fee and display an ANS sticker to legally operate watercraft on state waters. **This can be purchased at <https://gf.nd.gov>**

AQUATIC NUISANCE SPECIES

Help preserve our lake and prevent transfer of Aquatic Nuisance Species (ANS). Wash your boat, trailer, and pickup prior to entering Devils Lake. Also, to keep other organisms from spreading into our lake, clean and disinfect your live wells and other places lake water accumulates. Your cooperation is appreciated.

FISHING REGULATION HIGHLIGHTS

- A fishing year is defined as April 1 in any calendar year through March 31 of the following calendar year.
- The licensee shall carry the fishing license on his/her person at all times while fishing.
- Any nonresident under the age of 16 years may take and possess a limit of fish without a nonresident license if accompanied by an adult possessing a valid fishing license.
- ND law permits the use of boats legally numbered under the numbering system of another state for a period of 90 days.
- Ice houses are no longer required to be licensed. An unoccupied house does require identification. The house must display on its outside, in characters at least 3 inches high, owner's name and address or phone number.
- All aquatic vegetation must be removed from boats, personal watercraft, trailers, and fishing and hunting equipment such as fishing poles, bait buckets, lures, duck decoys, and waders, before leaving a body of water. That means "vegetation free" when transporting watercraft and/or equipment away from a boat ramp, landing area or shoreline.
- Live aquatic bait or aquatic vegetation may not be transported into North Dakota.
- All water must be drained from boats and other watercraft, including bilges, live wells, baitwells and motors before leaving a body of water.
- All drain plugs that may hold back water must be removed, and water draining devices must be open on all watercraft and recreational, commercial and construction equipment bilges and confined spaces during any out-of-water transport of same.
- All water must be drained from bait buckets as anglers leave the shore or remove their boats from the water. Anglers must properly dispose of unused bait away from the river, as dumping bait in the water or on shore is illegal. In all other waters not infested with Class I ANS species, anglers can transport live bait in water in containers of five (5) gallons or less in volume.

ASK PERMISSION FIRST

Want to hunt a parcel of land? Ask!

Many landowners and farmers welcome out-of-staters. There are a few “rules” to follow. Determine from the owner where to drive (stay on these roads), do NOT litter (empty shells, cans, etc.), close gates securely, get at least one-quarter mile away from buildings or livestock, smile and thank the owner for the privilege of enjoying North Dakota on their land.

Two types of hunters travel to Devils Lake. Some arrive in the fall with dogs and shotguns. Others hunt with cameras and eyeballs while taking in the splendor of bird-life and skies and waters filled with waterfowl.

Thousands of acres of wetlands (perhaps as much as a couple hundred thousand acres) with Devils Lake at the center beckon waterfowl. Ducks and geese have plugged Devils Lake into their internal GPS systems. The famed flyway is a major migration resting spot.

Connecting lakes, marshes, ponds, creeks, rivers and swamps plus miles and miles of harvested grain fields provide sanctuary and food. These same wet hotspots host hundreds of songbird species spring, summer and into fall when they head south.

Hunters fund conservation more than any other group. They buy state and federal licenses and pay excise taxes on gear, guns and ammo which directly supports state and federal wildlife efforts.

Devils Lake is one of the few areas in North America where all 41 waterfowl species (with the exception of saltwater species) either migrate through in spring and fall or can be counted in the dozen or so species that nest in and around this special region.



HUNTING

Those with cameras target waterfowl broods in June and July. They love the sight of massive flocks filling the skies spring and fall offer. Photographic opportunities abound. The Lake Alice National Wildlife Refuge 18 miles from Devils Lake attracts ducks, geese, wading birds, shore birds and songbirds to its 12,000 acres of shallow wetland and grassland. At White Horse Hill, ornithologists have identified 214 distinct bird species. White Horse Hill National Game Preserve 10 miles south of Devils Lake works in an interactive bird and wildlife partnership with the US Fish and Wildlife Service. Teaching about and showcasing the local, unique prairie potholes is a main attraction.

Shotgunners travel from throughout North America and the world to experience the fall waterfowl extravaganza. There are many guide services catering to hunters. The guides deploy hundreds of decoys in fields or on water to lure waterfowl. The guides are experienced. They've been at it for decades. They're experts. They scout daily and know where the birds are for the best "shoots." They know how to "talk" to the birds and call them. Guides cater to all their clients' needs.

Depending on the weather, many hunters take advantage of what's known locally as "Cast and Blast." They hunt mornings and fish the warmest part of the day into evenings. Fishing guides know fall is the best time for walleye limits and for real trophy-sized walleyes.

Whether armed with a camera or a shotgun, Devils Lake is the place where birds thrive. They live here. They call this region home when passing through. Visit and see what everybody's talking about!

ELECTRONIC ACCESS APP

Electronic posting of private land is now available in North Dakota. This makes it easy for hunters to determine the status of land (open or closed) as well as the owner. With that information, hunters may contact the owner when requesting permission to hunt.

There are two map applications, the PLOTS Guide viewer and the ArcGIS Explorer app. Posted lands are in dark orange crosshatch. Clicking on the parcel will display the individual who posted the land and may include additional contact details.

The PLOTS Guide map mobile app does not require cell service. Once uploaded, the app allows hunters to view location, posted lands, public lands and PLOTS tracts. Go to gf.nd.gov to upload the PLOTS app. The ArcGIS app requires cell service.

Landowners may also post with signs. If the land is entirely enclosed by a fence, posting of signs at gates constitutes a posting of the entire parcel. **The North Dakota code is simple, "Ask permission first."**

GRAHAMS ISLAND STATE PARK

Grahams Island State Park just west of the City of Devils Lake and located on the lake is one of the most used North Dakota state parks. It is named after Capt. Duncan Graham, the area's first white settler who arrived after the War of 1812. With 1,100 acres of wooded land, the park showcases 130 different native plants and a host of shore birds, waterfowl and song birds. Bird watching is a favorite past-time. The causeway to the Park stretches for miles and is a favorite shoreline fishing destination.

Amenities include modern and primitive camping sites, six sleeping cabins, an activity center, picnic shelters, playground, dog park, showers, meeting facilities, RV dump station, cross country ski trails, bait shop, boat rentals and boat ramp. **Park reservations: 800.807.4723 or 701.766.4015.**

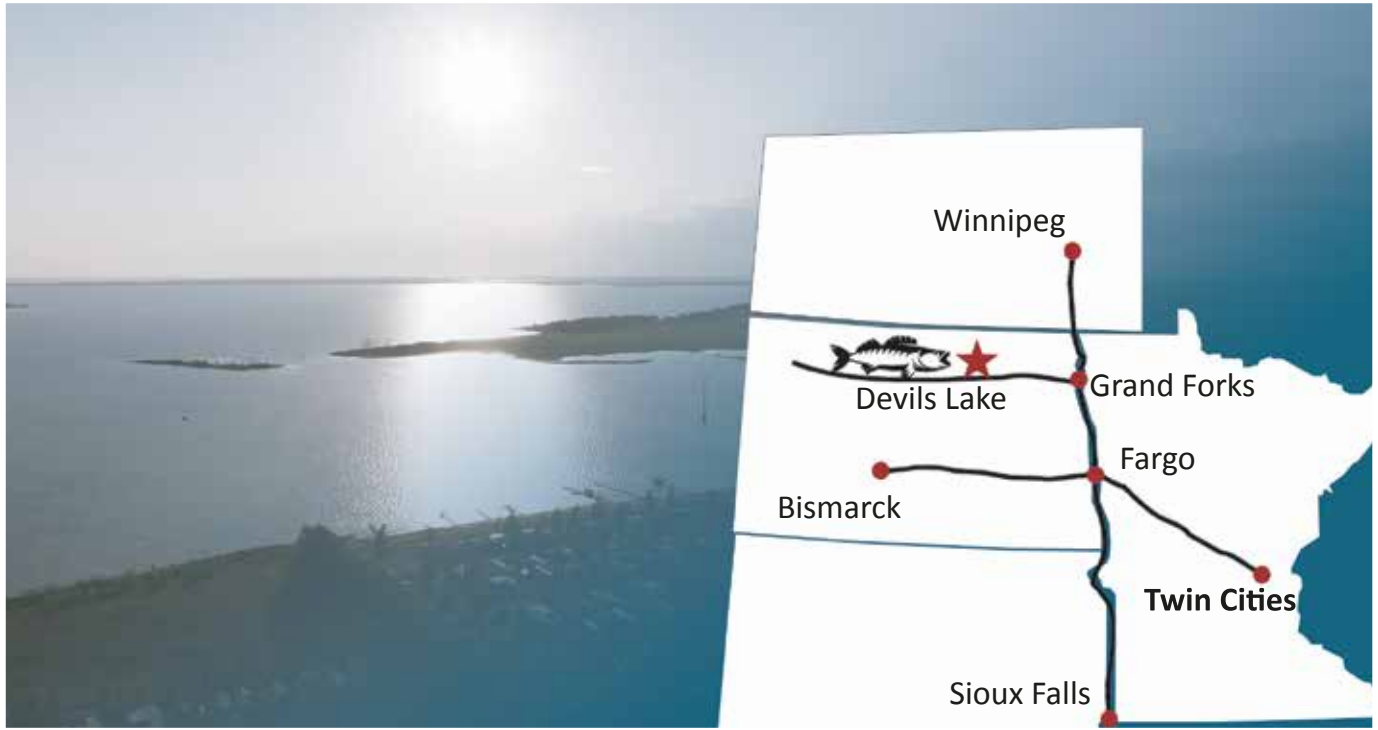

HISTORY



HISTORY FOR THE CURIOUS

Built in 1867, the Fort Totten Historic Site has served many purposes over the decades and has been restored to the look of its use as a fort. If you listen carefully, you can almost hear the soldiers marching in the square. For a more complete history, set aside time to enter the original buildings. Take in the Plummer's Store and stroll the wooden boardwalks. Stop at the Interpretive Center Gift Shop or check out the Traveling Exhibits. And why not complete the experience? Book a room at the Totten Trail Historic Inn (frontier-style bed and breakfast).

The downtown Devils Lake area is a historic monument to its origins from the 1880s. The charm of turn-of-the-century brick and design is seen on the buildings lining Main Street. Take a walking tour and view 59 buildings on the National Historic Register.

Stop in to investigate the Lake Region Heritage Center, museum and art gallery that houses the unique history of the Lake Region. Displays include the Old Post Office, Life of the Lake: Devils Lake, The Federal Courtroom, and other unique displays.

The Sheriff's House Museum is a stop where you can step back in time. It features parlors, kitchen and dining rooms, five bedrooms that have changed little from the time the residence was occupied in 1911. It also features exhibits narrating and interpreting the history of Devils Lake.

2024 has been an exciting year for Devils Lake, brimming with growth, new initiatives, and community spirit. One of the most notable achievements this year was receiving the Regional Workforce Impact Program Grant from the North Dakota Department of Commerce. 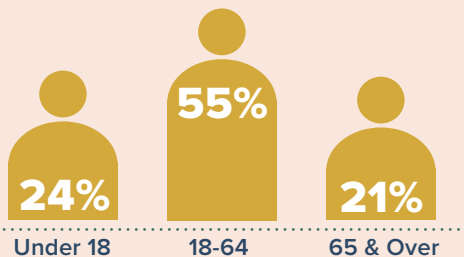

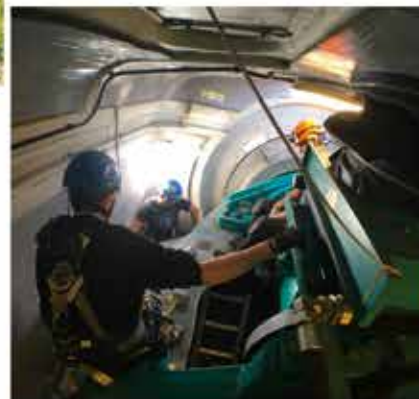
