DEVILS LAKE

Nestled in North Dakota's famed wheat and grain belt lies an enormous lake known as a fish factory. Devils Lake may have created more fishing smiles than any place else in North America—and it does so every day of the year. With open seasons year-round, the lake welcomes anglers for both open water and ice fishing adventures.

From May through November, boats fill the bays and shorelines as anglers chase their next big catch. When the ice sets in, the action doesn't slow—it just moves indoors. Local guides and outfitters make every trip seamless, offering gear, bait, and insider knowledge. Whether you're in a boat or an ice shelter, the first trip often turns into an annual tradition. Around here, fishing friends become family.

Four main game fish dominate Devils Lake and its connected waters. Once just 40,000 acres, this expanded body of water now spans roughly 165,000 acres—an angler's paradise filled with submerged roads, old farmsteads, and rocky shorelines that create perfect fish habitat.

More free, public fish-cleaning stations in and around Devils Lake than anywhere else.

SERVICE WITH A SMILE IS THE ATTITUDE OF DEVILS LAKE RESIDENTS. They pooled resources with fishing clubs, state departments, conservation organizations and others to build first-class fish cleaning stations at many launch sites. These are open from spring until freeze-up. There is also a year round heated or air-conditioned cleaning station just south of Ed's Bait Shop on Hwy 20. Fish cleaning station locations: Henegar Landing, Lakewood Landing, 6 Mile Bay, Spirit Lake Casino, Grahams Island State Park, Stump Lake Park Landing, Tolna Landing. Also, many resorts and motels have their own fish cleaning houses with freezers.

Handicap Accessible, Free, Public Fishing Piers

Special fishing docks for physically impaired and elderly fishermen have been installed on Channel A (great spring walleye highway), Henegar Landing, Pikes Playground and Fishing Pier and at the Creel Bay Lakewood Beach. For directions, check the Devils Lake website.

WALLEYE – THE HEADLINER

Devils Lake is world-famous for its walleye fishery. Every year, biologists with the North Dakota Game and Fish Department survey the lake, and year after year, results show a healthy, thriving population with strong numbers across all size classes. Anglers can expect a mix of 15- to 20-inch eaters and trophy-size fish over 25 inches. From spring's shallow action to summer trolling and winter ice fishing, the walleye bite never really stops. The limit remains five per day, ten in possession.

PERCH – ICE FISHING ROYALTY

Devils Lake reigns as North America's number one perch ice fishing destination. These golden beauties are not only fun to catch—they're some of the best-tasting fish in freshwater. Schools move fast, and guides keep clients on the action all day long. As local guide Mark Bry says, "Perch fishing is like an addiction—the tug is the drug." Limits are generous: 20 perch daily, 40 in possession.

WHITE BASS – FAST, FIERCE, AND FUN

White bass may not always be the main target, but they

sure know how to steal the show. These schooling fighters strike hard and keep the action going, often tipping the scales at three to four pounds. Whether casting in summer or jigging through the ice, white bass add a burst of excitement to any day on the lake.

NORTHERN PIKE – THE WATER WOLVES

Pike are everywhere in Devils Lake—sometimes they find you before you find them. Known for explosive strikes and thrilling runs, these predators offer unforgettable battles. Big pike are often caught year-round, with open-water anglers casting from shore in spring and ice anglers chasing flags in winter. They're as good on the plate as they are on the line—once you learn the art of filleting around the bones.

FISHING WITHOUT LIMITS ON DEVILS LAKE

That spirit lives strong on Devils Lake’s Creel Bay, where innovation and compassion have joined forces to make the outdoors truly open to everyone. The Merle Baisch Memorial Wheelchair Platform & Lift at Lakewood Park is a state-of-the-art system designed to help individuals with mobility challenges safely and easily access boats and experience the thrill of fishing—without barriers.

MERLE BAISCH MEMORIAL WHEELCHAIR PLATFORM & LIFT

A PERSONAL MISSION TURNED COMMUNITY MILESTONE

The project began as a personal tribute from Suzie Kenner, Executive Director of the Devils Lake Chamber of Commerce and Tourism, to her late father, Merle Baisch.

After surviving a devastating motorcycle accident, Merle’s determination to keep fishing inspired Suzie to seek better accessibility options for others. “It took over an hour to get him in and out of a boat,” she recalls. “That trip was our last together, but it planted the seed that led to this project.”

A few years later, Suzie discovered a similar lift system in Beulah, ND — and with the help of Wheelchairs and Walleyes founder Jeff Gooss, that spark turned into action. Through a community-wide effort, over 14 local and regional organizations helped raise \$190,000 to bring the project to life.

DRIVEN BY INCLUSION, BUILT FOR INDEPENDENCE

Designed and built in partnership with AE2S Engineers and Superior Walls of North Dakota, the lift features a solar-powered, ADA-compliant high-lift chair and accessible platform that make boarding and launching both safe and dignified.

The system includes:

- Aqua Creek high-lift chair with head and leg rests
- Chest and lap straps for secure transfer
- Solar charger and backup battery
- Winterized cover for year-round protection
- Permanent concrete base with integrated wheelchair ramp
- Future improvements will add ADA-compliant restrooms and adult-sized changing tables, expanding accessibility even further.

A GROWING LEGACY OF ACCESS

The Devils Lake installation joins a growing network of accessible lake lifts across the region, including Lake Sakakawea, Hazen, and Lake Minnetonka, MN, with additional sites planned in New York, South Dakota, and Montana.

As Gooss puts it, “This isn’t something that needs to be sold. It simply makes lives better.”

VISIT THE LIFT

Lakewood Park, Creel Bay – Devils Lake, North Dakota

Just a block from the main boat launch, the Merle Baisch Memorial Wheelchair Platform & Lift is open to the public and free to use.

ASK PERMISSION FIRST

Want to hunt a parcel of land? Ask!

Many landowners and farmers welcome out-of-staters. There are a few “rules” to follow. Determine from the owner where to drive (stay on these roads), do NOT litter (empty shells, cans, etc.), close gates securely, get at least one-quarter mile away from buildings or livestock, smile and thank the owner for the privilege of enjoying North Dakota on their land.

Where Wings Fill the Skies and Stories Take Flight

Two kinds of hunters make their way to Devils Lake each year: those with dogs and shotguns, and those with cameras and binoculars. Both come for the same reason — the thrill of being surrounded by thousands of waterfowl and the unmatched beauty of North Dakota’s prairie pothole country.

At the heart of it all lies Devils Lake — a natural hub for migration and a magnet for waterfowl. With hundreds of thousands of acres of wetlands, grain fields, and connecting lakes and marshes, this region provides a haven for ducks, geese, and countless other bird species. The skies come alive each spring and fall as birds follow their ancient flyways, resting and refueling here before continuing their journey.

A CONSERVATION LEGACY

Hunters have long been the unsung heroes of conservation. Through licenses, permits, and excise taxes on gear and ammunition, they directly fund critical wildlife management and habitat restoration. Thanks to those efforts, the Devils Lake region remains one of the few places in North America where nearly all 41 species of waterfowl — except saltwater species — can be seen migrating through or nesting nearby.

FOR THE BIRDWATCHER AND THE PHOTOGRAPHER

Devils Lake isn’t just for those pulling triggers — it’s paradise for those pulling out their cameras. Each summer, photographers flock to capture

broods of ducklings, swans, and pelicans gliding through the shallows.

Just 18 miles north, Lake Alice National Wildlife Refuge hosts more than 12,000 acres of wetlands and grasslands, drawing in waterfowl, shorebirds, and songbirds alike. To the south, White Horse Hill National Game Preserve offers a scenic mix of bison, elk, and over 214 identified bird species, making it a top destination for ornithologists and nature enthusiasts.

FOR THE WATERFOWLER

When fall arrives, Devils Lake transforms into a hunter's dream. Experienced local guides set up massive decoy spreads, scout daily flight paths, and call birds with precision that only decades of experience can bring. Hunters travel here from across the U.S. — and even overseas — for the legendary “Devils Lake shoot.”

Many combine the thrill of the hunt with the region's other passion: fishing. Known locally as the “Cast and Blast,” mornings are spent in the blinds, and afternoons chasing trophy walleyes as the sun warms the water.

WHERE WILDLIFE AND WONDER MEET

Whether you carry a camera or a shotgun, Devils Lake is a place where wild wings rule the sky and the landscape never stops moving. Here, the migration isn't just something you watch — it's something you feel.

Visit once, and you'll understand why so many return each year to experience North Dakota's premier waterfowl destination.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO: WATERFOWL ZONE UPDATES

North Dakota's 2025–2026 Small Game, Waterfowl & Furbearer Proclamation brought big changes for nonresident waterfowl hunters. The goal: spread out hunting pressure, improve habitat, and make access more fair for everyone.

Six Zones, One License

The state is now divided into **six nonresident waterfowl zones** — Northwest, Southwest, North Central, South Central, Northeast, and Southeast.

- Highways 200 and 1804 divide north and south.
- Highway 281 splits east from central, and Highway 83 separates central from west.

Hunters must choose **one zone per seven-day hunt period**, and they can't repeat the same zone twice. Those who hunt only once can select **two zones to hunt concurrently** in a single week.

Rules for using the zones:

- You have two separate 7-day hunting periods per year.
- In each period, you choose one zone.
- You cannot pick the same zone twice.
- You are allowed to hunt two different zones concurrently if you plan to hunt no more than seven days.
- Nonresidents are allowed one waterfowl license per season.

Why the Change?

The old three-zone system left most hunters crowding into one large region that covered 85% of the state. The new structure balances participation and protects habitat.

A New Conservation Boost

All waterfowl hunters — residents and nonresidents — now need a **\$5 Waterfowl Habitat Restoration e-stamp**, helping fund access improvements, youth programs, and future habitat restoration.

Other Key Notes

- Motorboats must have engines off while actively hunting.
- Extended goose hunting hours now include Fridays starting late November.

HISTORY



HISTORY FOR THE CURIOUS

Built in 1867, the Fort Totten Historic Site has served many purposes over the decades and has been restored to the look of its use as a fort. If you listen carefully, you can almost hear the soldiers marching in the square. For a more complete history, set aside time to enter the original buildings. Take in the Plummer's Store and stroll the wooden boardwalks. Stop at the Interpretive Center Gift Shop or check out the Traveling Exhibits. And why not complete the experience? Book a room at the Totten Trail Historic Inn (frontier-style bed and breakfast).

The downtown Devils Lake area is a historic monument to its origins from the 1880s. The charm of turn-of-the-century brick and design is seen on the buildings lining Main Street. Take a walking tour and view 59 buildings on the National Historic Register.

Stop in to investigate the Lake Region Heritage Center, museum and art gallery that houses the unique history of the Lake Region. Displays include the Old Post Office, Life of the Lake: Devils Lake, The Federal Courtroom, and other unique displays.

The Sheriff's House Museum is a stop where you can step back in time. It features parlors, kitchen and dining rooms, five bedrooms that have changed little from the time the residence was occupied in 1911. It also features exhibits narrating and interpreting the history of Devils Lake.


