ALL YEAR-ROUND

January – December

Santo Domingo de Fiesta: Free outdoor show full of folk music and dance, every Friday and Saturday at the Plaza de España in the Colonial City of Santo Domingo from 7 p.m. to 10 p.m.

January – December

Grupo Bonyé at the Colonial City: Free performances of son and merengue every Sunday in the Ruinas de San Francisco, in the Colonial City of Santo Domingo from 6 p.m. to 10 p.m.

January - December

Jazz Nights: Throughout the year, several venues in Santo Domingo offer free concerts of jazz, blues and other musical genres for locals and visitors. They are held Mondays at the Lulu Tasting Bar, Wednesdays at Acropolis Center and Fridays at the Dominican Fiesta Hotel & Casino. http://jazzendominicana.blogspot.com

January - December

Altos de Chavón Concerts: The amphitheater with the capacity for 5,000 people is popular for concerts, music videos and private events. Past concerts include Gloria Estefan, Sting, Shakira, Andrea Bocelli, Elton John, Juan Luis Guerra, Carlos Santana and Marc Anthony, among others. www.casadecampo.com.do

January – December

Golf Tournaments: All year long, golf tournaments are organized in various courses throughout the country. In the courses of Casa de Campo The Links, Dye Fore and Teeth of the Dog, the following tournaments take place: the 46th Annual International Pro AM, International Caribbean Pro AM I, 33rd International Caribbean Pro AM II and 16th Annual Casa de Campo Spring Shootout. Other important tournaments are held at Corales Golf Club, Punta Espada Golf Club and Playa Dorada Golf Course, among others.

January - December

Kitesurfing and Windsurfing Competitions: The idyllic Cabarete bay is known as home to some of the most spectacular kitesurfing and windsurfing events during the summer. The warm waters and the changing winds of the bay attract the fiercest competitors of water and sailing sports to participate in recognized international competitions.

January – December

La Puntilla Amphitheater Concerts: The impressive Greek amphitheater of 2,062 square meters (22,195 square feet) located between the Atlantic Ocean and Fort San Felipe, has capacity for 4,000 spectators. Throughout the year it is the perfect setting for concerts, dance shows and other entertainment events with the participation of Dominican and international artists.

<u>JANUARY</u>

January - March

Whale Watching in Samaná: Take a boat trip to watch between 1,500 and 2,000 humpback whales that migrate to the waters of Samaná Bay. The official whale-watching season is from mid-January to the end of March, but excursions are available while there are whales in the Bay.

January – April

Casa de Campo Polo Tournament: Annual event where the best polo players in the country meet in this famous tourist complex. It is regulated by the International Polo Federation. www.CasadeCampo.com.do

January 17 - 19

Caribbean Laser Midwinter Regatta: It opens the laser regatta world calendar every January in Cabarete, the world capital of kitesurfing. This event attracts the best sailors from around the world and is sponsored by the Laser Training Center, with the assistance of the Dominican Sailing Federation. www.caribwind.com

FEBRUARY

February - March

Dominican Republic Carnival: Its origin dates back to 1520, and it is a tradition inherited from the Spanish ancestors in which each city celebrates in its own way, including parades every Sunday in February. Some of these are celebrated in Puerto Plata, Punta Cana, Rio San Juan, Cabarete, Bonao, Constanza, La Vega, Montecristi, Samaná, Higüey, Barahona, Santiago and Santo Domingo. Some final parades are held in March. www.cultura.gob.do

February 2 - March 1

La Vega Carnival: Over half a million visitors come to see the colors and hear the sounds of the naughty Diablos Cojuelos, with their huge colorful masks and long horns. The parade is held every Sunday in February and includes live music.

February 7 - 8

Punta Cana Carnival: Visitors and locals celebrate carnival on November 1st Boulevard, in Puntacana Village. The parade on Saturday, February 8 has troupes from 15 provinces of the country and international ones with more than 1,000 characters with costumes and live performances. www.puntacana.com

February 16 - 21

Procigar Festival: More than 300 people from all over the world gather at the Procigar Festival in La Romana and Santiago. The event includes a golf tournament, excursions to the beach, merengue classes, seminars about cigars and much more. www.procigar.org

February 23 - 28

Master of the Ocean: The specialists of extreme water sports will test their qualities in the recognized unique event that brings together local and international athletes in high-level competitions and celebrations on the beach of Cabarete. It includes the disciplines of surfing, windsurfing, kitesurfing and stand up paddle (SUP) with a single winner and is one of the biggest events of its kind. www.masteroftheocean.com

MARCH

March – August

Fishing Tournaments and Regattas: During the summer the Puerto Bahía Marina holds sport fishing tournaments. Dorados, Tunas, Wahoos, as well as other species of billfishes such as White Marlin, Blue Marlin, Sailfish and Swordfish are some of the varieties you can find. In March, it is also very popular to hold regattas in the Samaná Bay with hundreds of sailboats from different countries.

March 1

National Carnival Parade: Held on the first Sunday of March in the Malecón of Santo Domingo. Typical carnival characters from all over the Dominican Republic gather in colorful troupes to offer an unforgettable show. www.cultura.gob.do

March 7 - 13

Conciertos de la Villa de Santo Domingo: Festival organized by the Santo Domingo Villa Foundation that includes concerts, art and cultural events aimed at the public in various historical sites of the Colonial City. Punta Cana Gourmet Week: Event that promotes the diverse and high gastronomic offer of the East side of the country among tourists, visitors and residents. March 20

Caribbean Cigar Night: With the long history of the Dominican Republic in the production of some of the best cigars in the world; this event, held in Puerto Plata, attracts a wide audience to discover and taste some of the most prestigious local and international brands. Puerto Plata Open: PGA Latin American Tour event that is part of the BUPA Challenge. It is held at Playa Dorada Golf Course, designed by Robert Trent Jones Senior. Expo Gastronómica: It gathers the main suppliers, institutions, products and services of the gastronomic and hospitality sector of the Dominican Republic.
