

## **Parking in Bridport and West Bay**

Bridport has five Long Stay and four Shoppers' (Short Stay) car parks. West Bay has one seafront, two harbourside and three Long Stay car parks. All car parks are operated on a Pay and Display basis.

Pay and Display tickets are not transferable between car parks. You are advised to read the charges board in each car park you visit as these vary depending on whether the car park is designated Short Stay or Long Stay.

**Season Tickets:** These are available from the Council Offices in Dorchester either on a quarterly or yearly basis, to enable regular visitors to park cheaper in our Long Stay car parks.

**Disabled Badge Holders:** Please refer to the disabled parking notices on display in each car park. Parking permits are available from Dorset Council Parking Services for those in receipt of the Higher Rate of Mobility Allowance or equivalent. The permits entitle holders to 3 hours free parking per day.

Larger Vehicles: Lorries, coaches, motorhomes, caravans, caravanettes, trailers etc can be accommodated at the West Street coach park in Bridport. At West Bay, coaches can park at West Bay Road coach park and all other vehicles can park at Station Road car park. Regular visitors may benefit from commercial season tickets, available from Dorset Council Parking Services.
