Urgent Care

Weymouth's Urgent
Treatment Centre and
a number of Minor

are still running seven
days a week, but by
appointment only.

Call NHS 111 to book an appointment.



Emergency Care

Emergency Departments (or A&E) should only be used in an emergency.

If you or someone you are with is in a life threatening condition, phone 999 and ask for an ambulance.

If you have symptoms of COVID-19 you must self-isolate immediately and book a test via gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test or call 119 and let your accommodation provider know.
