### **What is Tinsel Town?**

Tinsel Town is a display of live Christmas trees in Downtown Greensboro, December 4-27. An anticipated 50 trees will decorate the parking lot at Kontoor Brands for the holiday season.

### **Where is it located?**

Tinsel Town is located in LeBauer Park in Downtown Greensboro.

### **Who decorates the trees?**

Each tree is purchased by a local corporation, group or family, and decorated by its sponsor or a chosen non-profit. Trees can have themes that match the company's or non-profit's mission, or sometimes they're just totally unique! Each tree has a sign with the sponsor and decorator's names.

### **How can I participate?**

Sponsoring a tree is a great way to market your business all while supporting a non-profit organization. Visit the Sponsor a Tree page for details about our sponsorship program.

Tree sponsor price is \$200 for a 6-7 ft. tree.

If you'd like to support our initiative, but don't have time to decorate a tree just let us know and we'll donate your tree to a non-profit organization.
