What is Tinsel Town?

Tinsel Town is a display of live Christmas trees in Downtown Greensboro, December 2-31. An anticipated 50 trees will decorate the atrium in the Greensboro Cultural Center for the holiday season.

Where is it located?

Tinsel Town is located in the Greensboro Cultural Center in Downtown Greensboro.

Who decorates the trees?

Each tree is purchased by a local corporation, group or family, and decorated by its sponsor or a chosen non-profit. Trees can have themes that match the company's or non-profit's mission, or sometimes they're just totally unique! Each tree has a sign with the sponsor and decorator's names.

How can I participate?

Sponsoring a tree is a great way to market your business all while supporting a non-profit organization. Visit the Sponsor a Tree page for details about our sponsorship program.

Tree sponsor price is \$200 for a 6 ft. tree.

If you'd like to support our initiative, but don't have time to decorate a tree just let us know and we'll donate your tree to a non-profit organization.

If your organization would like to be considered as a non-profit decorator please submit your non-profit inquiry form to get on the waiting list for a sponsored tree. These trees are subject to availability, but we'll do our best to accommodate all requests.
