- <u>Hispanic Heritage Celebration</u> Dunwoody Parks and Recreation will kick off Dunwoody Arts & Culture Month with a family-friendly event celebrating Hispanic Heritage Month with live music, food trucks, arts & crafts and salsa dance lessons. Free and open to all ages, the event will run from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. on October 1 at Pernoshal Park, located at 4575 N. Shallowford Road.
- Spirits for Spruill From 4 to 7 p.m. on Saturday, October 15, this event at Spruill Art Gallery will coincide with the unveiling of the third annual AMPLIFY public art installation. This project aims to elevate a sense of community and seeks to connect people through art while promoting local, regional and national artists. The winning AMPLIFY artist is selected from applicants across the country. Guests will enjoy an evening of delicious food and beverages, live music and comradery to celebrate the reveal of this year's AMPLIFY mural on the wall of the Spruill Gallery Smokehouse. Tickets, available online for \$45, include event and mural unveiling access.
- <u>Stage Door Theatre, Ordinary Days</u> Guests can enjoy the refreshingly honest and funny musical, Ordinary Days by Adam Gwon. Running from September 30 to October 16, it tells the story of four young New Yorkers whose lives intersect as they search for what they want in

pursuit of what they need. Shows run Friday and Saturdays at 7:30 p.m. and Sundays at 2:30 p.m. Tickets range from \$15 to \$35 and can be purchased <u>online</u> using the "ARTSMONTH22" discount code.

- Stage Door Theatre, Zombie Prom: Atomic Edition Get into the spirit of Halloween with "Zombie Prom," a 1950s horror comic book brought to life as a musical comedy by John Dempsey. On Friday, October 28, and Saturday, October 29, at 7:30 p.m. and on Sunday, October 30, at 2:30 p.m., tickets range from \$10 to \$15 and can be purchased online using the "ARTSMONTH22" discount code.
- Our Favorite Things An art exhibit presented by the Dunwoody Fine Arts Association taking place from October 3 through November x.
- Friday Night Hikes Knowledgeable educators will lead a fun and informative hike through the Dunwoody Nature Center, teaching about nocturnal animals and their unique nighttime adaptations, taking place on Fridays from 8 to 9 p.m. Tickets are \$5 for both children and adults.

In addition to the events listed above, the Spruill Center for the Arts will offer a variety of day, evening and weekend art classes and workshops for adults, teens and children interested in expressing themselves creatively through jewelry, ceramics, drawing, painting, sculpture, glass, decorative arts, photography and more.
