FOR THE ADVENTURER

DAY 1

- Breakfast at Lone Star Cafe
- Drive north of Durango on Highway 550
- Mountain biking at Purgatory's bike park
- Lunch at Purgy's with views on the Needles Mountain Range
- Drive to Molas Pass for sunset
- Grab take-out from Serious Texas BBQ
- Dessert from Animas Chocolate

DAY 2

- Breakfast at Oscar's Cafe
- Drive north of Durango on Highway 550
- Enjoy the scenic drive on the Million Dollar Highway all the way to Ouray
- Pause at each of the mountain pass summits: Coal Bank, Molas, and Red Mountain Pass
- Stop for lunch in Silverton
- Stop for coffee in Ouray
- Soak at the Rico Hot Springs on the way back from Durango
- Dinner at Steamworks Brewing Company

DAY 3

- Quick breakfast from Bread
- Pick up some freshly-made sandwiches and a Zuberfizz for lunch from 2nd Street Deli before heading out
- Rent a side-by-side from Durango Rivertrippers or Altitude ATV
- Drive to Silverton and unload the side-by-side and begin riding on CO Rd 2 towards Animas Forks
- Top out and eat lunch at Engineer Pass where CO Rd 2 meets CO Rd 20; turn around here
- Pack up once you get back to Silverton and drive back to Durango
- Pizza at Fired Up Pizzeria

DAY 4

- Breakfast at College Drive Cafe
- Drive north of Durango on Highway 550
- Park at Coal Bank Pass and begin your hike on the Engineer Mountain trail
- Hike as far as you want enjoying views of the mountains along the way
- Head back to Durango after your hike
- Dinner at James Ranch for dinner
- Soak at the Durango Hot Springs Resort and Spa
