Beverley is a historic market town granted a charter in 1128 which has been shaped by its cultural and trading past. Easily explored on foot, the town is steeped in history and is home to two impressive churches, Beverley Minster and St Mary's, pretty market squares and beautiful Georgian townhouses.

This map has been created to celebrate the thriving mix of high-quality independent businesses across the town centre, alongside popular markets every Wednesday and Saturday.

The primary retail and leisure offer stretches for approximately a mile from North Bar Within in the north-west of the town centre to the Flemingate Shopping Centre in the east.

Toll Gavel is the main shopping thoroughfare that connects Wednesday Market to Saturday Market - two vibrant market squares. Additionally, Flemingate Shopping Centre has lots to offer for all the family including fashion, food, fun and film.

Core independent shopping areas to explore include North Bar Within, Ladygate, Dyer Lane, Swarby's Yard and Wednesday Market.

North Bar Within

North Bar is a medieval gatehouse built in 1409 and is the sole survivor of the gates that once guarded entrances to the town. North Bar Within offers fine examples of Georgian architecture and is home to an abundance of high quality independent retail and hospitality businesses.

Dyer Lane & Swaby's Yard

Dyer Lane and Swaby's Yard is an arcade of pedestrianised streets featuring independents including clothing, gifts, interior design, and hospitality.

Flemingate

Flemingate brings fashion, food and film close to East Yorkshire's historic heart offering an independent cinema and mix of shops, boutiques alongside local creative talent.

Saturday Market

Beverley's famous market dates back centuries and attracts thousands of shoppers every week. The market has a vibrant mix of stalls selling food from around the world, fruit and vegetables, freshly baked goods, homewares, arts and crafts, and clothing.

Wednesday Market

Wednesday Market is the site of Beverley's oldest market and has a number of small independent shops to complement a selection of eateries. A weekly market takes place each Wednesday.
