ELIZABETH, NJ - HISTORY'S BEST KEPT SECRET


This tour will guide you through all of the different eras of Elizabeth, from when it was first purchased in 1664 to the mid-18th century where Elizabeth was one of the most prominent cities in New Jersey; thus becoming the first colonial capital; and its 19th century transformation which turned Elizabeth into a transportation hub, thanks to railroad lines, highways and steamboat shipping. This tour will allow visitors to linger and experience an era of the city's rich history and development as the permanent seat of government in the County of Union.
