




Museum School Partnership

Liberty Hall Museum is proud to present a unique opportunity for schools to work in partnership with museum educators to take advantage of a comprehensive set of educational activities.

The Museum School Partnership provides a rich selection of resources that enhance and augment classroom learning. Beginning with a day-long field trip to the museum, students are transported back in time with period-dressed museum educators guiding them through a series of activities that bring the past to life. The field trip can be followed by an in-school visit from a museum educator for a classroom presentation with artifacts and hands-on activities. These outreach programs normally last 45 minutes and multiple sessions can be scheduled on the same outreach. Finally, students can participate in our Windows to the Past program. Using the technology of Face Time, students speak with historic characters who are positioned within an accurate historic setting. Teachers can choose from a menu of historical figures from the 1770s through the 1940s who will discuss their life and times followed by a question and answer session with students. Teachers will receive an advance packet with activities and information about their selected historical figure. Finally, participating schools will be eligible for a discounted rate at the museum's Professional Development Workshops. Museum School Partnerships are available on a limited basis and will be tailored to meet each participating school's needs.
