Explore the most beautiful parts of Freeman Lake by kayak! Bring your own kayak or rent one at Freeman Lake's Park office.




HAVE A BALL WHILE YOU'RE HERE

OUTDOORS ARE FOR EVERYONE





Kayaks, Paddle Boats and Row Boats can all be rented by the hour.


Age 15 and under do not require a license to fish. 16 years of age and above need to purchase both a State and City permit. A single day pass can be purchased at the Park Office.
