(Exhibits and wax figures feature the life of Lincoln)

12:30 p.m. - Visit **Abraham Lincoln's Boyhood Home** in Knob Creek

(Recently reconstructed, the 16th president labeled the Knob Creek home his "earliest recollection")

1 p.m. - Inspect railroad artifacts in New Haven at the

Kentucky Railway Museum

(Ride the train through Rolling Fork River Valley.

Lunch available on trains for groups)

3:30 p.m. - Learn how bourbon is made at **Maker's Mark Distillery** in Loretto

(Each lot is checked a minimum of 5 times while aging)

(Experience the state-of-the-art interactive exhibits and learn to appreciate the single barrel bourbons inside the Parker Beam tasting barrel)

2:30 p.m. - Grab a drink at **Old Talbott Tavern** in Bardstown
(America's oldest western stagecoach stop)

3 p.m. - Taste bourbon at the **Jim Beam Distillery** in Clermont
(Learn how the barrel makers developed their craft and visit the tasting parlor)
