- Bristol: Elkhart County Historical Museum (Pinwheel).
- Elkhart: Central Park (Autumn Blaze); Concord Town Center & Mall (Floral Fiesta); Linton's Enchanted Gardens (Hope Blooms Bright); Premier Arts (The Amazing Technicolor Dream Quilt); Ruthmere Museum (Elkhart Founder Homestead); Wellfield Botanic Gardens (Window to Waters).
- Goshen: Elkhart County 4-H Fairgrounds (4 Cornerstones of 4-H); Elkhart County Courthouse (Goshen on Fire); Old Bag Factory (Burns Building Blocks).
- Middlebury: The Barn Door (Diamonds Are Forever); Das Dutchman Essenhaus (Vibrant Blooms in Dresden Plate); Dutch Country Market (Dutch Country Windmill); Krider World's Fair Garden (Krider Star Point); Martin's ACE Hardware (A Burst of Joy).

- Elkhart: Concord Town Center & Mall (Jazz It Up); Elkhart County Visitor Center (Aurora); Elkhart Public Library main branch (Educate, Enlighten & Entertain); Time Was Museum (Old Fashioned Star); Wellfield Botanic Gardens (Pinwheels & Ribbons of Hope); West View Florist & Gifts (Grandmother's Flower Garden).
- Goshen: Goshen Chamber of Commerce and Visitors Center (Maple Leaf); Old Bag Factory (Miles II Variation).
- Middlebury: Das Dutchman Essenhaus (Double Wedding Ring); Downtown Middlebury, 107 E. Warren St. (Interlocking Hearts of Hope); Martin Ace Hardware (American Made); Varns & Hoover Hardware (Welcome to Middlebury — four murals).
- Nappanee: Amish Acres (Blue Bird Thing); John's Butcher Shop (Amish Quilt Commemorative Stamps — four murals).
