2023: RECORD BREAKING YEAR

The Elmhurst History Museum was busier than ever in 2023! With a range of thought-provoking exhibits and expanded public program offerings, the museum enjoyed its highest attendance records to date. This year saw a dramatic surge in new elementary school field trips and portable programs, taking the museum directly into the classroom. To offer diverse programs that meet the needs of our community, we also ramped up our groundbreaking efforts to engage seniors facing memory challenges with our new “Memories Matter: Senior Recollections” program, which we bring to area nursing homes and memory care facilities.

Here are a few highlights from a year that took our audiences on an eclectic journey through history: We began 2023 with an insightful and powerful retrospective on DuPage County’s growing diversity featuring the stories of local immigrants. Taking full advantage of the beautiful summer weather, we enjoyed outdoor events at the museum, history bike rides through town, and more with our summer bicycle exhibit. The year then came to a close with a nostalgic look into the evolution of department stores in the Chicagoland area – visitors reminisced with their own shopping experiences, especially leading into the magical holiday season.

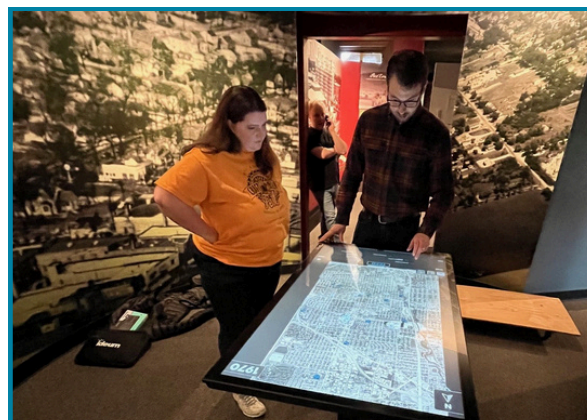

IMMIGRANTS IN OUR COMMUNITIES

October 28, 2022 - May 14, 2023

In Pursuit of Happiness: Immigrants in Our Communities

2023 started on a strong foot with the continuation of *In Pursuit of Happiness: Immigrants in Our Communities*, a popular exhibit that was paired with unique programming and events, including a riveting performance by the Chicago Immigrant Orchestra and our Cultural Crossroads Celebration, held in partnership with the York High School International Club, Immigrant Solidarity DuPage, and the Xilin Foundation. The exhibit showcased the immigration stories of many residents of DuPage County through interviews and the objects they shared to be displayed in the exhibit.

June 9 - September 17, 2023

The Bicycle: Two Wheels to Adventure

During the summer, EHM took a spin through the history of the bicycle with *The Bicycle: Two Wheels to Adventure*. Visitors learned about the many ways this 19th-century invention significantly impacted Chicagoland manufacturing, transportation, and infrastructure, and how the bicycle redefined an era of newfound leisure and independence. The story of the 'human-powered carriage' was told through examples of iconic bicycles, artifacts, and timeless photographs. The exhibit also featured a spotlight on Elmhurst adventurer, educator, and World's Most Traveled Man, J. Hart Rosdail, by sharing artifacts and tales from his record-setting journey across the globe on his trusted bicycle, Jacqueline.



October 6, 2023 - January 28, 2024

Lost Chicagoland Department Stores

Heading into the end of the year, EHM took guests back in time to learn about the eclectic history of Chicagoland retailers with our most popular exhibit to date. Featured in *Forbes*, WGN-TV's "Around Town" segment, *Chicago Tribune*, and many more, *Lost Chicagoland Department Stores* enjoyed a wealth of media attention and strong foot traffic throughout its run. Produced in collaboration with historian and author, Leslie Goddard, the exhibit explored the evolution of the retail industry and brick-and-mortar stores, such as Marshall Field & Co. and Montgomery Ward. The museum offered extended hours towards the end of the exhibition to allow patrons' to visit, if not for a second or third time!

By All Accounts: The Story of Elmhurst

Originally opened in 2015, our core exhibit, *By All Accounts: The Story of Elmhurst*, was beautifully refreshed in 2023. Numerous enhancements were made to the exhibit, including the addition of a portrait by famed 19th-century artist G.P.A. Healy, a new introduction covering the natural history and indigenous peoples of the region, as well as a revamped version of our award-winning digital map table of Elmhurst.

PROGRAMS

The museum's public programming continued to introduce engaging, diverse activities for audiences of all ages. Many of these learning opportunities were designed to connect with exhibition themes with a few seasonal favorites returning as well. Some of the key programs and events in 2023 included:

- ➔ In spring, EHM hosted drop-in Spring Break activities, including a **Family History Day** and **Immigration Storytime**. May also saw our **Cultural Crossroads Celebration**, which featured a performance by the Illinois Shaolin Kung Fu Academy.
- ➔ EHM had a busy summer with the return of **Museum Maker Mondays** and our **Vintage Baseball Game**. Elmhurst also rolled along with our summer exhibit and enjoyed a **History on Wheels Bike Tour**, **Open Road at Elmhurst Safety Town**, and **Bike Bonanza** in July which welcomed over 500 people.
- ➔ With the launch of a nostalgic new exhibit, fall and winter featured a **Bus Tour to Macy's on State St.**, a **Holiday Gift Wrapping Workshop**, numerous lectures, and **Sip Local with Brewpoint Coffee** here in Elmhurst.



EDUCATION

EHM saw the demand for fieldtrips and portable classroom programs grow throughout 2023 with schools and scout groups returning to the museum in pre-Covid levels. This year **689 students** visited the Churchville One-Room Schoolhouse and **over 1,000 children** participated in portable programs, including the newly introduced **Hardship and Homefront**, which teaches students about the hardships of Civil War soldiers and those left behind at home while exploring the contents of a soldier's trunk and reading mid-19th century letters.

The museum's adult programming and education offerings expanded significantly in 2023 with the introduction of new **Adult Portable Programs** and **Memories Matter: Senior Recollections**, a series of programming aiming to encourage seniors to reminisce about their life experiences and share their stories. Originally conceived at the McLean County Museum of History under the name Senior Reminiscence, this series of programs, with topics including **Photo Reminiscence**, **Toys of Yesteryear**, and **Hearth & Home**, is especially valuable to individuals facing memory challenges.

In the summer, EHM's sold-out **Museum Explorers Camp** returned with a full week of fun STEAM-focused activities and adventures for curious kids in grades 2 – 5.

COLLECTION & RESEARCH

The collections staff continued the ongoing work of managing, organizing, digitizing, and caring for the Elmhurst History Museum's collections. Some of the projects accomplished in 2023 include:

- ➔ A long-term project came to fruition with the installation of the **Jane Byrd Bryan portrait** by **G.P.A. Healy** in EHM's core exhibit.
- ➔ Another key achievement was the installation of a **new interactive Map Table** in *By All Accounts: The Story of Elmhurst*. The map table installation caps a year of upgrades to EHM's core exhibit, which began in November 2022.
- ➔ New **History Spotlights** were added to the second floor gallery throughout 2023, including a display commemorating the 100th anniversary of the Wilder Park Conservatory, a spotlight on the Elmhurst Great Western Prairie, Stemple's Bicycle Shop, and a display about the **Churchville One-Room Schoolhouse**.
- ➔ The Collections Department created engaging online content for our patrons with new **Elmhurst History In Focus** shorts on our YouTube channel. In addition to producing online gallery talks for our 2023 exhibits, three new videos were created, focusing on Elmfest, the Elmhurst Great Western Prairie, and the relationship between G.P.A. Healy and the Bryan family in Cottage Hill.
- ➔ Staff added more than **1,000 digital files** to the museum's digital collections. Additionally, the launch of the museum's **new website** this year saw our public-facing database integrated into our own website for the first time, realizing a long-term goal of the department.
- ➔ Staff continued to contribute Facebook and Instagram posts, most notably the weekly **Throwback Thursday Series**. 2023 saw the most popular TBT posts the museum has ever produced, with our top post this year accumulating a reach of 64,200 (more than 4 times larger than the top posts of 2022).

- ➔ An 8mm film reel documenting the **Elmhurst Police Department**, circa 1969.
- ➔ A **travel trunk** belonging to Walter Glos, son of Jacob and nephew to Henry, circa 1910s.
- ➔ A photograph of **John F. Kennedy** following his rally at York Community High School in 1960.
- ➔ Two **carved wooden columns** from the German exhibition hall at the 1893 World's Columbian Exposition.

The Foundation celebrated its **15th Anniversary** of serving the community through advocacy, education, and fundraising in April.

Hosting the largest **Elmhurst Craft Beer Fest** to date, with over **1,200 attendees**, the Foundation raised much needed funds for programs, exhibits, and more.

The Foundation hosted **after-hours exhibit opening receptions** for members, donors, sponsors, and media for multiple new exhibitions.
