To complement our 2024 exhibition *Victory at Home: 1941-1945*, which explores the steadfast and resourceful generation of civilians who banded together on the Home Front during World War II, the Elmhurst History Museum is excited to partner with Elmhurst City Centre to honor our WWII veterans. Over 1,800 residents of Elmhurst served in the military, and we hope to honor a few of these men and women by featuring them on lamp post banners along a section of York Street from Memorial Day through Labor Day 2024.

Located on N. York Street, between W. Second and W. Third Street, these banners will feature an Elmhurst World War II veteran, including their photograph, branch of service, and rank. **Due to the limited number of banners, applications are on a first-come-first-serve basis**. Thanks to the support of the Elmhurst Heritage Foundation and Elmhurst City Centre, there is no cost to apply for a banner this year.

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE APPLICATION

- The veteran must have been a resident of Elmhurst, Illinois during World War II (1939-1945). Residency and service will be checked against the Elmhurst Honor Roll and available service records.
- > Veteran must have served in the United States military between 1939-1947.
- Have a high-resolution (300 dpi or more) photograph of your veteran. You may bring the photograph in to be scanned; it must be at least 5 inches x 7 inches.
- > Only one application per family is allowed.

We understand we cannot feature all 1,800 Elmhurst WWII veterans on the banners. For those whose applications did not make it in, we will feature a couple of veterans a week on our social media platforms throughout the exhibition's run. We will also feature the complete Elmhurst WWII Honor Roll list in our exhibition space.
