The observatory schedules private and group viewing sessions and hosts educational lectures on astronomy, cosmology, astrophotography and special astronomical events.

The Field Institute offers more than 40 free kids classes throughout the summer on topics including wildlife, geocaching, kids survival and more.


While most often seen during fall and winter, summer sightings of big game are common. Smaller animals beaver, coyote, chipmunk, squirrel, raccoon, badger and marmot—are abundant year-round. During summer, birds and butterflies abound. Tiny hummingbirds, brilliant bluebirds, noisy nutcrackers, magpies and jays share the air with hundreds of butterfly species. Far above there are raptors: golden eagles, peregrine and prairie falcons and red-tailed Cooper's hawks.

Just passing beneath the entrance gate inspires a fondness for simpler times as Percheron draft horses and ranch hands can be seen working the hay meadow alongside grazing Black Angus cattle. The main ranch house has been transformed into a museum, perfect for children's groups and summer visitors to learn more about this rugged and rewarding way of life.


Built by wealthy businessman Freelan Oscar Stanley—who was known for his steam-powered car, the Stanley Steamer—The Stanley Hotel is one of the most important and significant landmarks in Estes Park dating back just over 100 years.

Pikas in the Park is a scavenger hunt throughout Estes Park, offering a wonderful tour of the village along with historical facts in honor of the Estes Park Centennial. This activity includes 12 bronze sculptures of Pikas, the small mountain-dwelling relatives of rabbit, placed throughout downtown.
