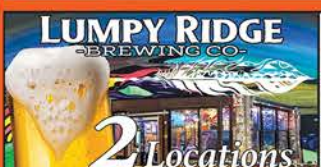

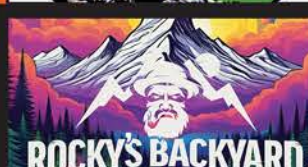
Pikas in the Park Scavenger Hunt
