49 Line Sets

Operated from SL Fly floor – 10'- 0" above stage floor

Grid Height: 61'- 0"

Bottom of Loft: 60'- 0"

Maximum Fly Height: 59'- 0"

Battens- See Line Set Schedule

49 – 70'- 0" Double Purchase on 6" centers

4 – 70'- 0" Motorized dedicated Electric battens

2 – Motorized dedicated Orchestra Shell ceiling panels

Arbor Capacity: 2,000lbs (1,000lbs at pipe)

Chain motors can be rigged from the Grid using 4" schedule 80 pipe sections.

Standard safe rigging practices are required.

Dedicated Sound points – located 3'- 0" DS of proscenium

Points DS of Plaster – located 10'- 0" DS of proscenium at every 8'- 0" across

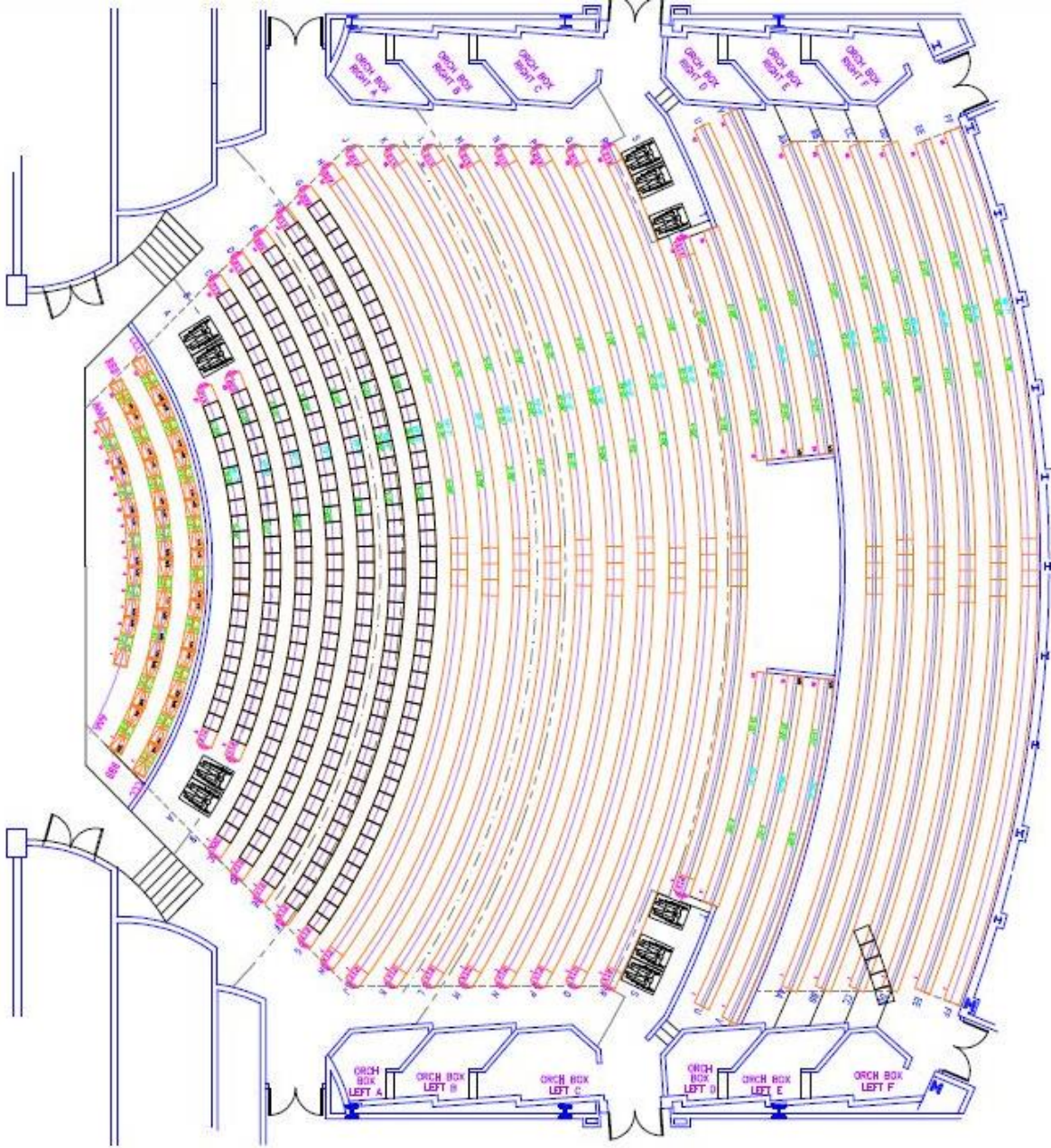

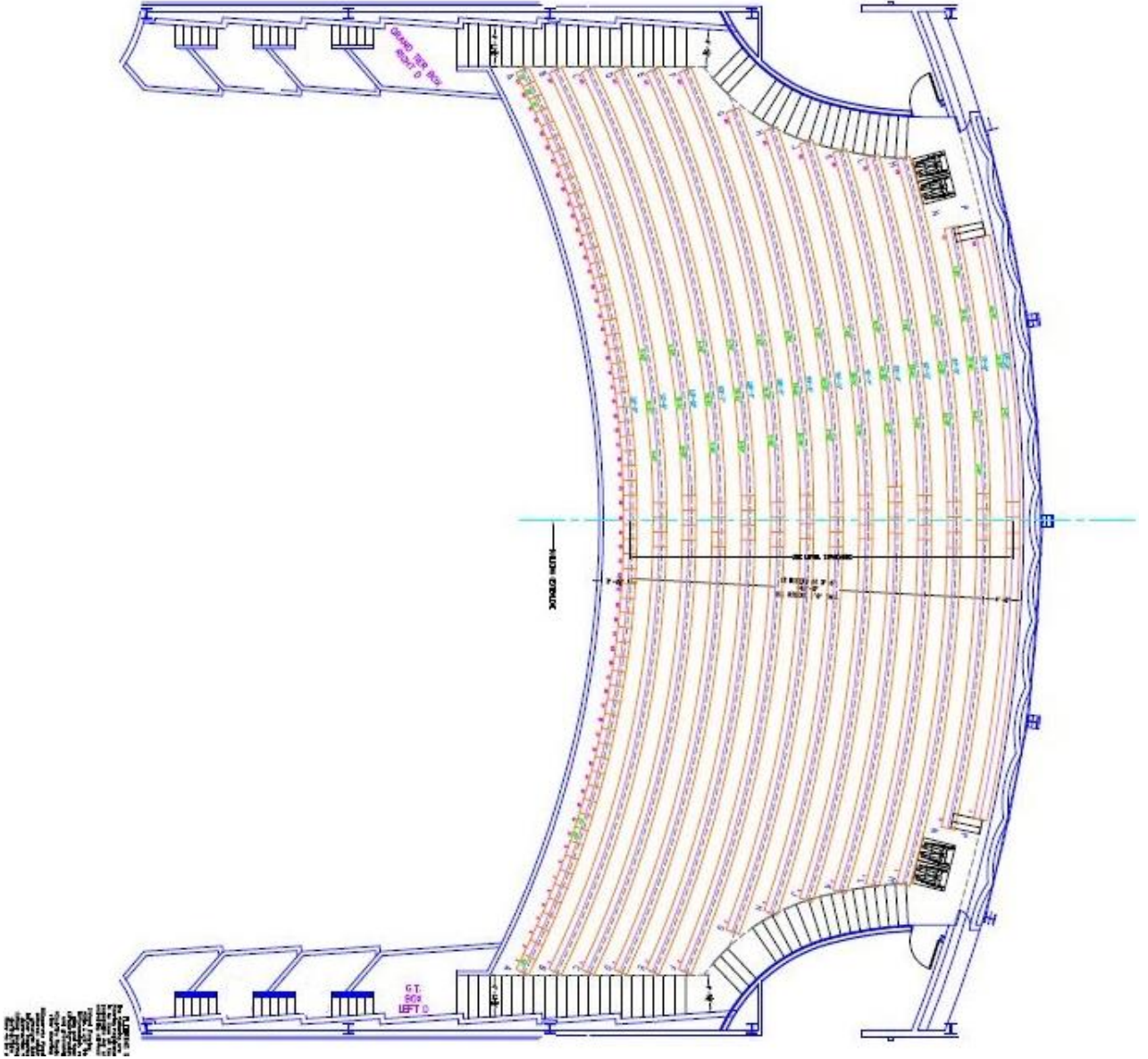


- Left and right stack has EAW MH660E long throw md/hi, 2 BV525 long throw bass, and MH690IE mid throw mid/hi.

- The center cluster has EAW AS690 mid/hi/low, and MH690IE hi/mid/short throw.
- There are MK2194 speakers positioned on the catwalks, and various other smaller speakers on the pit lip and under balconies.

- (3) 12" conduits run from FOH to the orchestra pit. Road snakes must use these, as there are no center aisles in the auditorium.

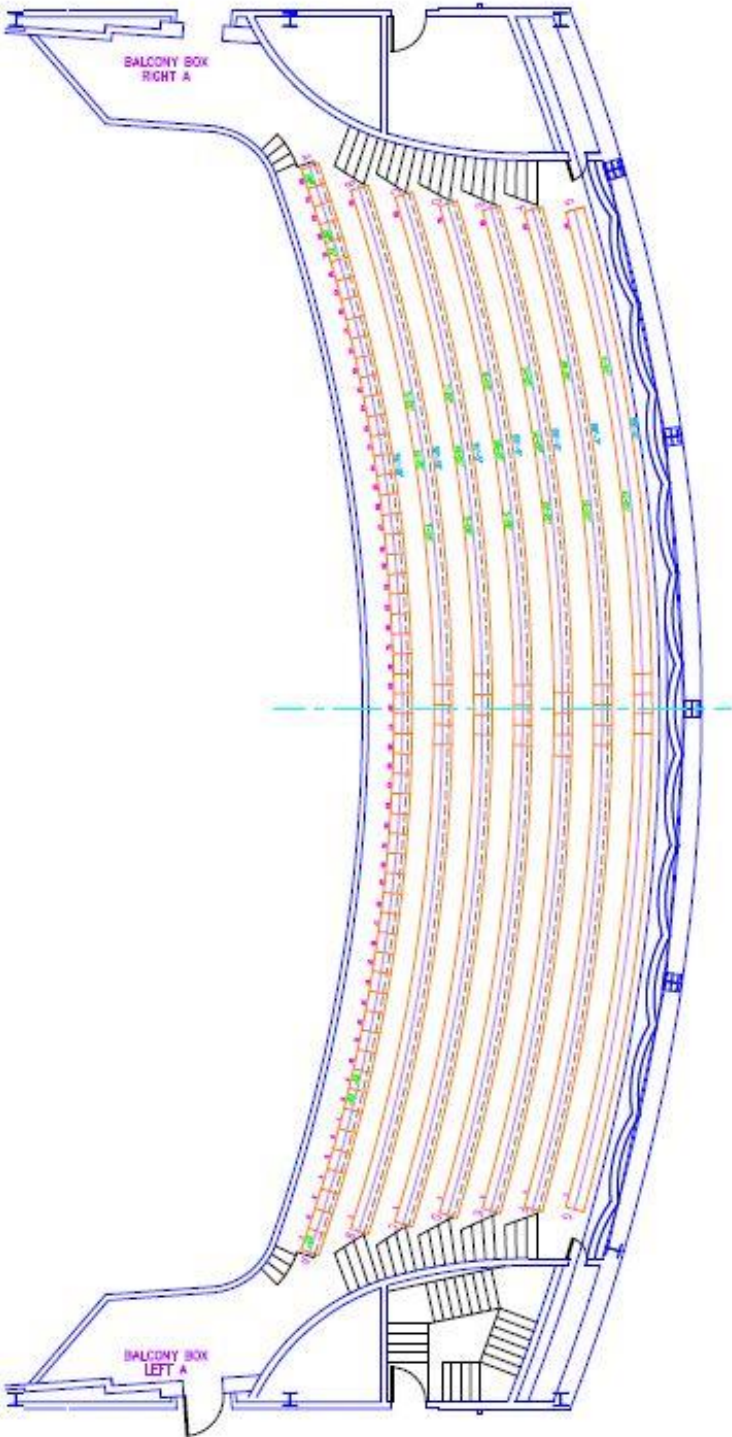

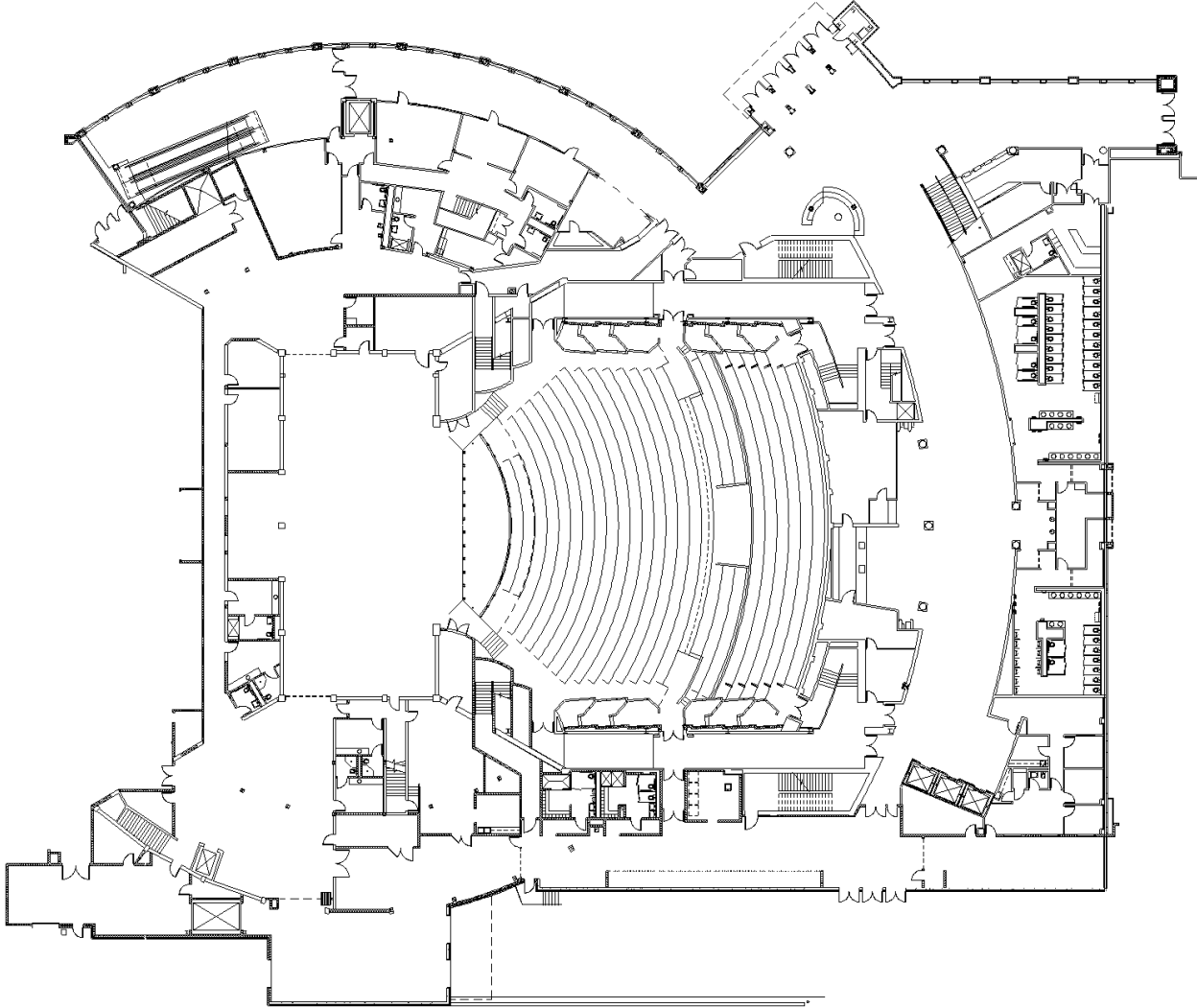
