Explore Fairbanks sends good cheer to you and yours for a healthy and happy holiday season. Adding to the fun of reconnecting with colleagues, friends and family, the holidays also open the door for reflections on the past year. Together with you, our business partners and community stakeholders, we had a merrily productive 2015:

- Explore Fairbanks destination video won two awards: in February, the North American Travel Journalists
 Association's Silver award in the Destination Videos and, in July, the Public Relations Society of America
 Alaska Chapter's 1st Place Award of Excellence for Video Material
- Explore Fairbanks greeted a record number of visitors and provided customer service at the Morris Thompson Cultural and Visitors Center with more than 120,000 visitors to date
- Hosted 23 press tours for a total of 40 travel media and 12 "familiarization" tours with a total of 40 tour operators and travel agents
- Celebrated the 15th anniversary of Condor Airlines in Fairbanks
- For the 2nd time in its history, Fairbanks hosted the Iditarod restart
- The 13th Annual Visitor Industry Walk for Charity raised \$19,100, with 100 percent of the donations distributed to 44 charities and, since its inception, the walk has raised \$314,800
- Generated economic impact from meetings by collaborating with UAF and stakeholders to position Alaska's Golden Heart City as the arctic hub community for the United States
- Facebook "likes" are currently more than 105,000
- Golden Heart Gala honored 24 Golden Heart Meeting Ambassadors who brought more than \$4.67 million in Estimated Economic Impact and 21 Golden Heart Greeter volunteers who donated 179 hours of service
- Welcomed China Airlines' three Taipei-to-Fairbanks charters and, with market demand for Fairbanks still strong in Japan, another charter airline also with three flights all six in December
