

Fairfax County Breweries Field Guide FAQs

What if I forget my paper Field Guide? Can I check-in on the app instead and combine them with my Field Guide stamps?

For tracking purposes, you must fully complete the program using only one method. Either collect all 9 paper stamps and turn in your hard copy Field Guide OR use the app to check in to all 9 breweries digitally. For example, you may not complete 3 paper stamps and 6 digital check-ins to redeem. You didn't hear this from us, but we suppose you could fully complete the paper guide AND fully complete the digital guide – though we imagine you must have been incredibly thirsty!

Where do I find the digital version of the Field Guide?

Download the free Visit Fairfax travel app for iPhone or Android devices and look for the Beer icon on the bottom menu!

How do I redeem my incentives?

Once you have collected all brewery stamps in the paper field guide, either bring your guide to the Fairfax County Visitor Center or mail the guide to Visit Fairfax for redemption. If you complete all check-ins on the app, fill out the form that appears after your last stop to redeem. We will then send you your free Fairfax County Breweries keychain, which you will need to bring with you to our breweries for redemption of your incentives. (You will receive emails with information about upcoming incentives.)

Can I keep my stamped guide as a souvenir after I redeem it?

Of course! Once you redeem your guide, we'll verify you have the stamps, punch a hole in it to indicate it has been redeemed, get you your free Fairfax County Breweries keychain, and then return the Field Guide to you so you can show it off to your friends.

Do I have to be 21 years old to get a field guide participate in the program?

You don't have to be 21 to get a guide and take a tour of the breweries. But you do have to be 21 to redeem your completed stamped guide, receive your branded keychain, and get the incentives from the breweries.

Do I have to purchase any beer at the breweries to participate in the program?

No you don't. But what fun would that be.
