

Getting Here & Getting Around

Visitors have plenty of ways to get to and around Fairfax County



PLANES

Fairfax County sits between Washington Dulles International (IAD) and Ronald Reagan Washington National (DCA), with Baltimore-Washington International Thurgood Marshall (BWI) only 45 miles away. With three great airport options, you can compare flights for both convenience and affordability.



TRAINS

Amtrak offers passenger rail service between Union Station in Washington, D.C. and major eastern cities. The AutoTrain is available from Lorton, VA to Sanford, FL, and Virginia Railway Express (VRE) runs from Manassas and Fredericksburg to Union Station, with five stops in Fairfax County.



AUTOMOBILES

Visitors can choose to drive to Fairfax County and the National Capital Region using four major interstates — I-66, I-95, I-395, and I-495 all run through the county and are the main transportation arteries by which many people arrive. Once here, our guests will enjoy one of the county's great perks: an abundance of convenient and — in many cases — free parking.



METRORAIL AND METROBUS

Metrorail is not just a convenient way to access many of the region's most memorable attractions — it's part of the vacation experience itself. There are 14 Metrorail stations within Fairfax County, many of which offer parking facilities and bicycle racks. Visitors can conveniently travel by Metrorail to D.C., as well as to both Dulles and Reagan airports. Metrobus operates routes throughout Fairfax County and to Metrorail stations.



BUSES

The Fairfax Connector provides another great option for bus service to many Metrorail stations throughout the county, to great attractions like George Washington's Mount Vernon and the Smithsonian's National Air and Space Museum Steven F. Udvar-Hazy Center, and to world-class shopping and dining in Tysons, the Mosaic District, Reston Town Center, and Springfield Town Center.



BIKES

Northern Virginia is known for its amazing bike trails, with more than 500 miles in Fairfax County alone. Explore quiet, tree-lined streets and trails using the county's excellent interactive map of routes. Bike rentals are available.
