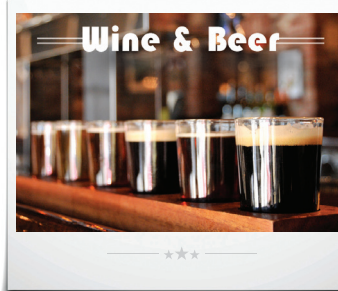
Theatre — Presenting world-class entertainment and a diverse collection of performances, the Capital Region's theatre scene attracts renowned artists from across the nation and the globe.
