Afternoon Treat: Caramel apple from <u>Uncle Zip's</u> or the "Everything

Fall Cupcake" at <u>Smallcakes Cupcakery</u>.

Evening: Dinner and firepit vibes at *Dirtbag Ales* with food trucks.

Sunday

Morning: If it's the first of the month you have GOT to brunch at <u>226</u> <u>The Warehouse</u> — a local favorite for their Sunday Funday menu, live music, and laid-back atmosphere.

Midday: Warm up with a cup of seasonal white bean turkey chili from <u>The Fried Turkey Sandwich Shop</u>, then browse mums at <u>Pate Farmer's Market</u>, pick pumpkins at <u>Gillis Hill Farm</u>, and wander the corn maze at <u>Gallberry Corn Maze</u>.
