# Metrics Associated with the Fayetteville Duck Derby 2016

Held April 24, 2016



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
### Introduction

- All data was collected and provided by the Duck Derby staff.
- There would be an estimated **5,000** attendees as reported by the Duck Derby staff.
- There were 302 completed surveys.
- Using the **5,000** attendees, the Confidence Interval for this presentation with a 302 Sample Size is **+/- 5.47**%. Because of the size of the sample the Confidence Interval **did not meet** the "best practice" of **+/-** 5%.





### They Identified Themselves as...



- 57% ■I am a resident of Fayetteville/Cumberland County.
- 16% I am from a surrounding county and drove in for the day for this event.
- 10% I am stationed or affiliated with Fort Bragg and live in Cumberland County.
- 6% I am here for the event and staying with family or friends.
- 5% I am visiting the area for other purposes, but heard about the event and came.
- 3% I am in the area visiting family or friends and they brought me to this event.
- 2% I am here for this event specifically and am overnighting in a hotel.
- <1% I am staying at a hotel and the hotel referred me to this event.



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# Where Were They From?

#### **Overview**

- Of the 302 completed surveys 5 provided an invalid zip code.
- 88% were from North Carolina, and 88% were from within 100 miles of Fayetteville.
- 57% identified themselves as being a "Resident of Cumberland County" with 10% identifying as being "Stationed or Affiliated with Fort Bragg and Live in Cumberland County".



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### Bottom Line

- The sample size of **302** was less than the required **357** completed surveys necessary to ensure the presentation met "best practices" of +/- 5%, as a result this presentation is at +/- 5.47%.
- 5,000 attendees
- Room Nights
  - o 1.99% of attendees (6 attendees) were overnighters and came specifically for the event
  - They averaged 1 overnight
  - Extrapolated out to 5,000 attendees this means potentially 100 people stayed overnight in a hotel
  - 100 people X 1 overnight in hotel = 100 room nights (+/- 5.47%)
- Of those that stayed in a hotel, the following hotels were mentioned: Holiday Inn I-95, Hampton Inn and DoubleTree.
- 3 attendees were referred by hotels.
- 67% were from Cumberland County including Fort Bragg.
- 16% were day trippers.
- 30% of attendees heard of event by Word of Mouth and 17% from some form of Social Media.
- 31 attendees signed up for the FACVB's E-Promotion Program.
