- Snap a photo at the Angel Wings outside Greg's Pottery.
- Visit the Love Locks Wall inside Cursive—bring or buy a lock!
- 'Welcome to Fayetteville' J. Cole mural at 208 Rowan Street.
- Explore the Arts Council Mural Walk behind the Arts Council.
- Old Street Oasis—lush, tropical, and totally unexpected.
- Captain of Your FAYte—nautical vibes and empowering words.
