



<> TURN BY TURN DIRECTIONS

PATRIOTS PAST & PRESENT TRAIL

STOP 1

FAYETTEVILLE AREA CONVENTION & VISITORS BUREAU (FACVB)

245 Person Street, Fayetteville, NC

Exit the FACVB parking lot, making a left on Person Street. Enter roundabout; take the third exit onto North Cool Spring Street. Cross Creek Cemetery will be on your right.

STOP 2

CROSS CREEK CEMETERY

North Cool Spring and Grove Streets, Fayetteville, NC

Turn around on North Cool Spring Street. The F.I.L.I. Parade Grounds/Memorial is on your right.

STOP 3

FAYETTEVILLE INDEPENDENT LIGHT INFANTRY COMPANY MEMORIAL

Cool Spring Street and Meeting Street, Fayetteville, NC

Fifer's Grave is at the same location as the F.I.L.I. Parade Grounds and Memorial.

STOP 4

FIFER'S GRAVE

Cool Spring Street and Meeting Street, Fayetteville, NC

Continue on North Cool Spring Street toward Person Street. Make first right out of the roundabout on Person Street. Continue on Person Street until you reach the corner of Person and Bow Streets.

STOP 5

LIBERTY POINT

Person and Bow Streets, Fayetteville, NC

Continue on Person Street until you reach the Market House directly in front of you at a traffic circle, a block ahead.

STOP 6

MARKET HOUSE

Intersection of Person and Hay Streets with Green and Gillespie Streets, Fayetteville, NC

Continue around the traffic circle, Person Street becomes Hay Street. Make a right onto Ray Avenue. Make a right onto Maiden Lane. Make a right onto Burgess Street.

STOP 7

FAYETTEVILLE INDEPENDENT LIGHT INFANTRY ARMORY

Burgess Street, Fayetteville, NC

Continue on Burgess Street. Cross over Hay Street. Burgess Street becomes Maxwell Street. Continue on Maxwell Street until you reach Franklin Street. Cross over Franklin Street. Turn right into the Fayetteville History Museum's parking lot.

STOP 8

FAYETTEVILLE HISTORY MUSEUM

325 Franklin Street, Fayetteville, NC

Make a left out of the parking lot onto Maxwell Street. Make a left onto Franklin Street. Make a right onto Robeson Street. Make a right onto Walter Street. Follow the signs to turn into the Airborne and Special Operations Museum parking lot.

STOP 9

AIRBORNE AND SPECIAL OPERATIONS MUSEUM

100 Bragg Boulevard, Fayetteville, NC

Iron Mike is located at the entrance of the Airborne and Special Operations Museum.

STOP 10

IRON MIKE STATUE

At the entrance of the Airborne and Special Operations Museum, Fayetteville, NC

North Carolina Veterans Park shares a parking lot with the Airborne and Special Operations Museum.

STOP 11

NORTH CAROLINA VETERANS PARK

300 Bragg Boulevard, Fayetteville, NC

Freedom Memorial Park is located across the street from the North Carolina Veterans Park and the Airborne and Special Operations Museum, at the corner of Hay Street and Bragg Blvd. Exit the museum parking lot and turn left on Bragg Blvd. The parking lot is on your right.

STOP 12

FREEDOM MEMORIAL PARK

101 Bragg Boulevard, Fayetteville, NC

Turn right out of the parking lot onto Bragg Blvd. Make a right onto Hay Street. Make a left onto Bradford Avenue. Make a right onto Arsenal Avenue.

STOP 13

MUSEUM OF THE CAPE FEAR HISTORICAL COMPLEX

P 801 Arsenal Avenue, Fayetteville, NC

Make a right onto Arsenal Avenue. Make a left onto Bradford Avenue. Make a left onto Hay Street and follow signs to Fort Bragg, via Morganton Road. Make right onto All-American Freeway and follow all the way to Fort Bragg. ***Only U.S. Citizens may enter the post. All visitors must stop at All-American Welcome Center, on the left, show ID, and receive Visitors Pass to access Fort Bragg.*** Once through the gate, take All-American to Longstreet Road. Turn right onto Longstreet Road. Turn right onto Sedgewick Street. Proceed to Sedgewick and Jackson Street.

STOP 14

MAIN POST CHAPEL

Sedgewick and Jackson Streets, Fort Bragg, NC

Turn around on Jackson Street. Make a right onto Sedgewick Street. Make a right on Capron Street. Make a left onto Macomb Street. Make a left onto Reilly Street (Reilly Street becomes Zabitosky Street). Make a left onto Ardennes Street.

STOP 15

JFK MEMORIAL CHAPEL

Building D-3116, Ardennes and Zabitosky Streets, Fort Bragg, NC

Continue on Ardennes Street.

STOP 16

JFK SPECIAL WARFARE MUSEUM

Building D-2502, Ardennes and Zabitosky Streets, Fort Bragg, NC

Turn right on Ardennes Street and Colonel Arthur D. "Bull" Simon's Statue is located in the JFK Special Memorial Plaza.

STOP 17

COLONEL ARTHUR "BULL" SIMONS STATUE

Ardennes and Marion Streets, Fort Bragg, NC

Turn left on Ardennes Street and 82nd Airborne Division War Memorial Museum will be on the right.

STOP 18

82ND AIRBORNE DIVISION WAR MEMORIAL MUSEUM

Ardennes Street, Fort Bragg, NC

From parking lot, turn left on Ardennes Street. Turn right on Yadkin Road.

STOP 19

SPECIAL OPERATIONS MEMORIAL PLAZA

2929 Desert Storm Drive and Yadkin Road, Fort Bragg, NC

Monroe's Crossroads Battlefield Site is under the jurisdiction of the Fort Bragg Cultural Management Resources Program (CRMP). It can only be accessed with a CRMP guide present. Please call the CRMP to see

if access is available. They will direct you as to how to get to their location once on Fort Bragg. ***Only U.S. Citizens may enter the post. All visitors must stop at All-American Welcome Center, show ID and receive Visitors Pass to access Fort Bragg.***

STOP 20

MONROE'S CROSSROADS BATTLEFIELD SITE

Call (910) 396-6680 for directions to location, Fort Bragg, NC

From Randolph Street make a left onto Bragg Blvd. Follow Bragg Blvd until it merges with NC 210, Murchison Road. Follow Murchison Road just past Fayetteville State University. Turn right on Blue Street. Turn left onto Bragg Blvd. Make a right onto MLK Freeway (following signs for I-95 North). From I-95 North, exit at #65 for NC-82 toward Falcon and Godwin. Continue on NC-82 following signs for Averagesboro Battlefield Complex.

STOP 21

AVERASBORO BATTLEFIELD COMPLEX

3300 Highway 82 South, Fayetteville, NC

Follow NC-82 to Main Street. Make a left on Main Street. Merge onto I-95 South. Exit at #56 for Fort Bragg Fayetteville US 301 South. Make a right onto Person Street. Make a right onto North Cool Spring Street to access the FACVB parking lot.

STOP 22
