 - Pause at the Freedom Memorial Park
- Lunch downtown at Blue Moon Café or Agora.
- Pop into local shops like A Bit of Carolina for literary finds, artisan gifts, and Southern hospitality.
- Catch a local performance, gallery show, or cultural event.
- Check into your hotel and order room service or delivery from one of Fayetteville's fave flavors like A Taste of West Africa or Nak Won Korean Restaurant.

Day Two: Tucked-Away Treasures

- Start your day at Rude Awakening Café.
- Explore downtown murals and architecture.
- Guided or self-led tour through Heritage Square.
- Have lunch at Gaston Brewing Company or Archway Burgers & Beer.
- Visit the Museum of the Cape Fear Historical Complex.
- A quiet moment at Cross Creek Cemetery.
