Day 1 – Hit the slopes and enjoy apres ski

Bristol Mountain Ski Resort located at 5662 Tour 64 in Canandaigua sits on a base elevation of 1,000 feet and rises to a 2,200 foot elevation at the mountain summit. The 1200’ vertical rise is the highest vertical between the Adirondacks and the Rocky Mountains.

Day 2 – Set out for the day to explore the sites in Victor & Rochester

Ganondagan State Historic Site in Victor, NY stands at the location of what was one of the largest, most vital 17th-century Seneca towns until its destruction in 1687. Bring snowshoes, cross-country skis or hiking boots to explore the grounds. 7000 County Road 41 (Boughton Hill Road), Victor, NY 14564

Next up visit the **Susan B. Anthony House** (17 Madison St, Rochester) where she was standing as she was arrested for voting. You’ll also find **Mt. Hope Cemetery** in Rochester (1133 Mt. Hope Avenue, Rochester, NY 14620) where Susan B. Anthony is laid in her final resting place.
