Howland Stone Store Museum - Built in 1837 by Slocum Howland for use as a store, this stone building has had many uses. After his death, Howland's son William, built a new structure on the property, known as The Block, to house the store and the stone building became storage. In 1883, Williams wife and daughter created a Museum of Curiosities compiled from the world travels of the Howland family. At an unknown later date, the Museum of Curiosities was relocated from The Block to the upstairs of the cobblestone building. Prior to her death in 1966, Alice Koon transferred ownership of the building to the Cayuga Museum, with the stipulation that it should continue to operate as a library on the first floor and a museum on the second floor. In 1996, the site was declared a Historic Site on the National registry, and a Authentic Site of (UGGR) The Underground Railroad, based on Slocum Howland's extensive involvement in the UGGR and Abolitionist activities.
