**Cumming Nature Center** is a dynamic 900-acre environmental education facility located near Naples, NY. Owned by the Roches- ter Museum and Science Center, it celebrates the unique landscape and culture of the Finger Lakes Region through hands-on learn- ing opportunities and thoughtful exhibits. Nestled between Canandaigua and Honeoye Lakes, this nature preserve is as beautiful as it is vast. Visitors can explore the visitors center and hike more than 15 miles of trails through diverse habitats. From rare hemlock bogs to active beaver ponds to the iconic 90-year old red pine stand, there's something for everyone at CNC!

Winter is a beautiful time of year at the Cumming Nature Center! Enjoy 12 miles of groomed ski trails and a 3-mile loop for snow shoeing. A \$15 ski package and \$5 snow shoe rentals are available. There is also a \$5 per person admission during ski and snow shoe season for trail maintenance. They also offer ski lessons each Saturday (snow willing!) and you can also call to potentially book a Sunday lesson as well. Register online or call 585-374-6160.

All ski lessons are dependent on weather conditions.

The nature center's landscape is constantly changing. Day by day and season by season, the cycles of nature play out in vernal pools, quiet glades, and deep snowbanks.
