Ganondagan, meaning The Town of Peace, is a bridge between yesterday and today. The only New York State Historic site dedicated to a Native American theme, 569 acres, Ganondagan is the original site of a 17th century Seneca town, that existed there peacefully more than 350 years ago. The culture, art, agriculture, and government of the Seneca people influenced our modern understanding of equality, democratic government, women's rights, ecology and natural foods. Explore the fullsize, fully furnished Seneca Bark Longhouse a typical Seneca family from the late 1600's, complete with reproductions of 17th century objects and colonial-era trade goods. The newly built interactive Seneca Art & Culture Center (2015) at Ganondagan State Historic Site is a 17,300 square foot center that tells the story of Haudenosaunee (Iroquois) contributions to art, culture, and society.
