Susan B. Anthony Museum & House – Rochester, NY

Inspiring others through Susan B. Anthony's life work is the purpose and passion of The National Susan B. Anthony Museum & House. Home to the legendary American civil rights leader, and the site of her famous arrest for voting in 1872. This building housed the headquarters of the National American Woman Suffrage Association when she was its president. Here is where she died in 1906 at age 86. At the Susan B. Anthony House, you will join the generations who have visited the Anthony Museum to experience the connection of power of place.
