DAY ONE

Sterling Nature Center - Sterling, NY

Wander through this unique park that features glacially formed bluffs, with scenic vistas of Lake Ontario. During the snow season, all trails are open to cross country skiing, snow shoeing, and hiking. You can even borrow snowshoes here! With 11 trails ranging from .5 miles to 11 miles in length, many options await for exploration, discovery, inspiration, learning and tranquility.



Prison City - Auburn, NY

Enjoy some drinks, and great food at this woman owned restaurant and brewery. The kitchen creates a blend of high-end pub and comfort foods with a focus on using local ingredients. New York State Equal Rights Heritage Center - Auburn, NY

You will learn about New York State's progressive history supporting equality through interactive displays that come to life as you wander around these state-of-the-art exhibits. Experience the creative ways trailblazing women organized a stand for justice and learn about the key contributors from the 1800s to modern day. The Center also includes a Taste of NY store featuring local products and provides information on the region's many attractions, and destinations.

Anthony, Harriet Tubman, Elizabeth Cady Stanton, to Lucille Ball, Oprah Winfrey and 2021 Inductee, Michelle Obama. Wander about browsing the exhibits that celebrate the Inductees, and showcase stimulating stories of past and present hard-won achievements.
