

Victor is home to several inviting parks, a well developed trail system and special feature attractions. Don't miss Ganondagan State Historic Site with its ethnobotanical trails and Mary Frances Bluebird Haven, a living classroom dedicated to the conservation and rehabilitation of the bluebird, New York State's official bird.


The Dryer Road Park multi-use trail system includes a variety of single-track trails, which are ideal for hiking, mountain biking, snowshoeing and cross-country skiing. Dryer Road is a great location for geocaching. Park trailhead shows an extensive map. The park also includes a bicycle pump track and skills area, picnic shelter, children's playground and year-round restrooms.
