



# Question 1. What is the "Visit Ontario County COVID Relief Program"?

Answer: In accordance with the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act (the CARES Act), Ontario County received a \$1,000,000 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) grant to help the community build back stronger and more resilient from the COVID-19 pandemic.

Ontario County Economic County Development Corporation (OCEDC) established the "Visit Ontario County COVID Relief Program" on behalf of Ontario County and is working with the Finger Lakes Visitors Connection (FLVC) to administer these funds to small businesses in the tourism and hospitality industry that have been negatively impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Program will provide grants to eligible businesses to support customer and staff safety, improve, and expand business operations, and improve business resiliency.

### Question 2. What type of support will the "Visit Ontario County COVID Relief Program" provide?

Answer: Assistance will be in the form of a grant of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds made to an eligible business applicant. Program assistance will not be considered where the amount of the required assistance is less than \$10,000, and total program assistance provided to a single business shall not exceed the aggregate amount of \$60,000.

#### Question 3. Who is eligible for the "Visit Ontario County COVID Relief Program"?

Answer: To be eligible to apply for the "Visit Ontario County COVID Relief Program," you must be

- o a small, for-profit business
- located in Ontario County, NY
- o in the tourism and hospitality industry that was impacted by the pandemic.
- Your business must have 25 or fewer employees at the time of application
- Your business is looking to create new jobs, restore jobs or retain jobs that are at risk of being lost.

Answer: Applications for the "Visit Ontario County COVID Relief Program" will be accepted and awarded on a rolling basis, and are available on a first-come, first-serve basis.
