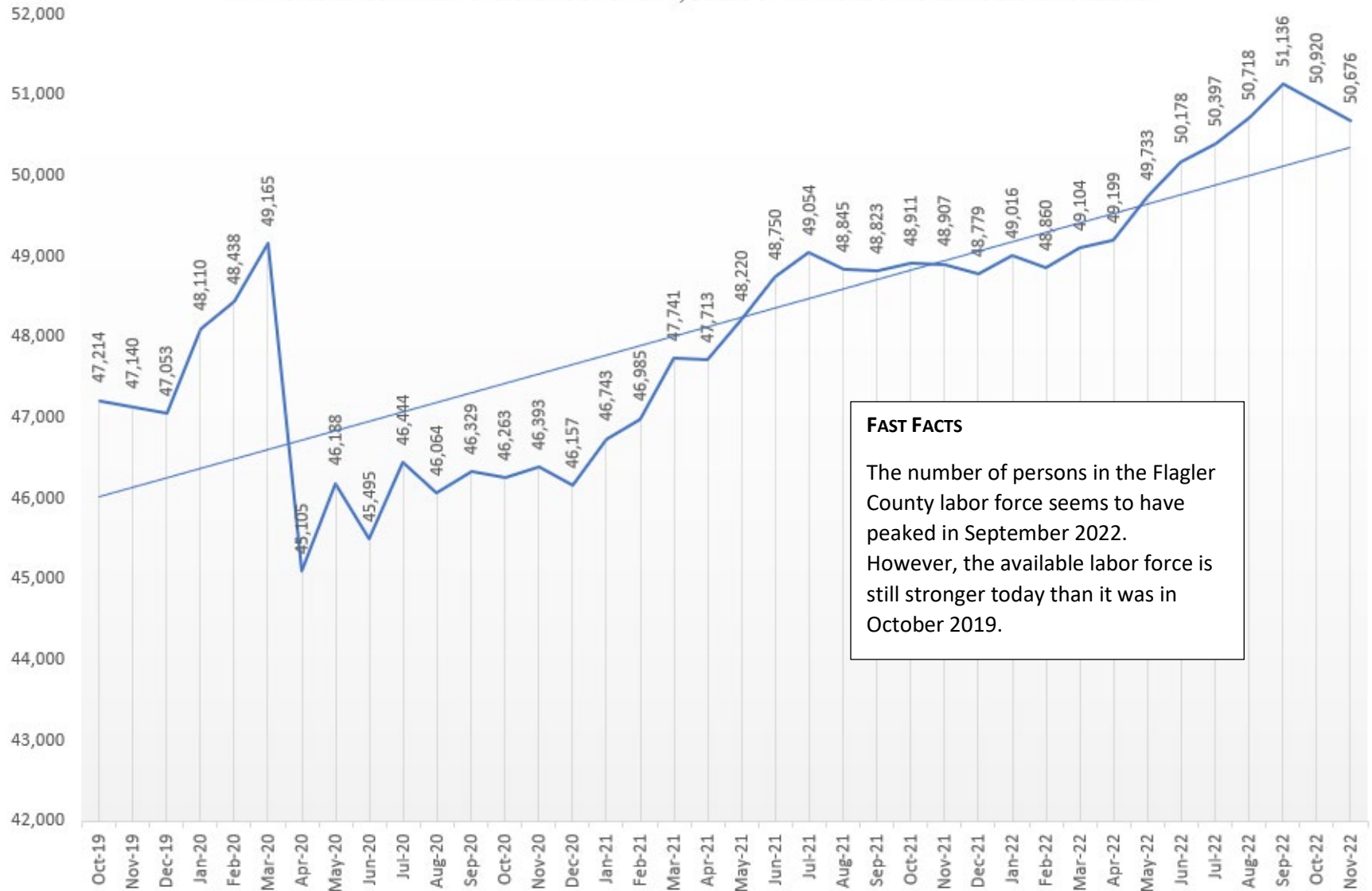


LABOR FORCE RESIDING IN FLAGLER COUNTY

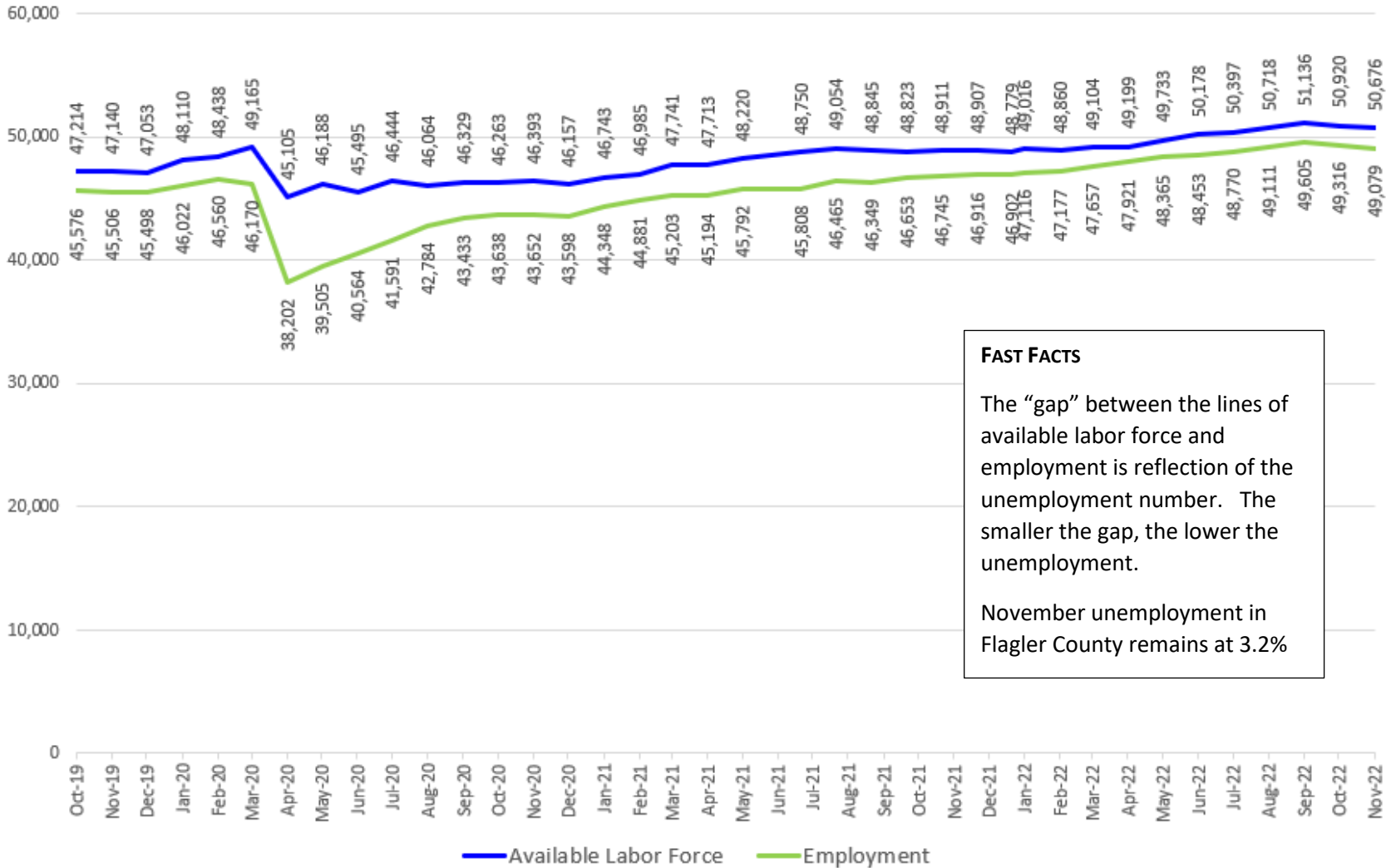

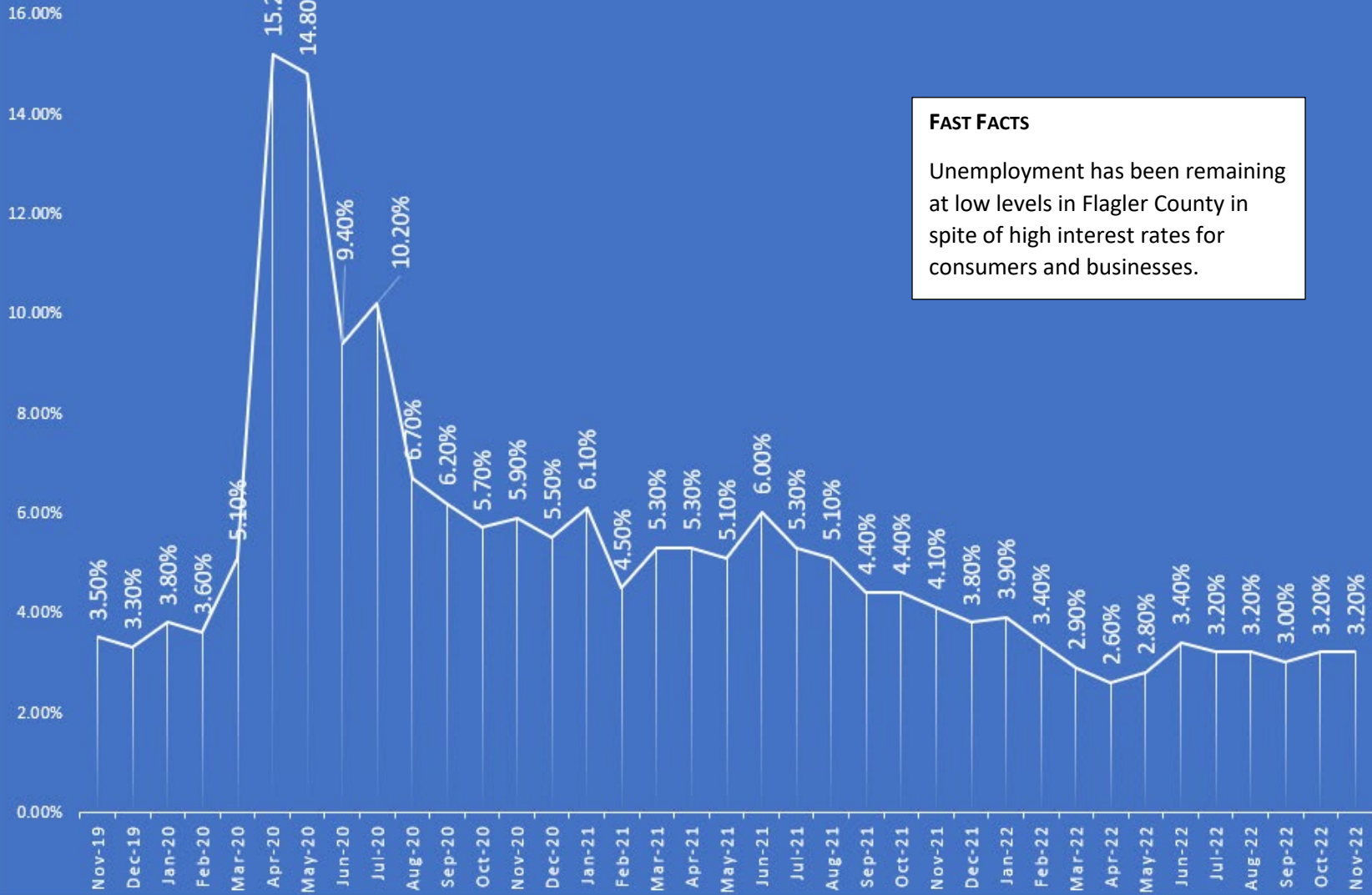
FAST FACTS
