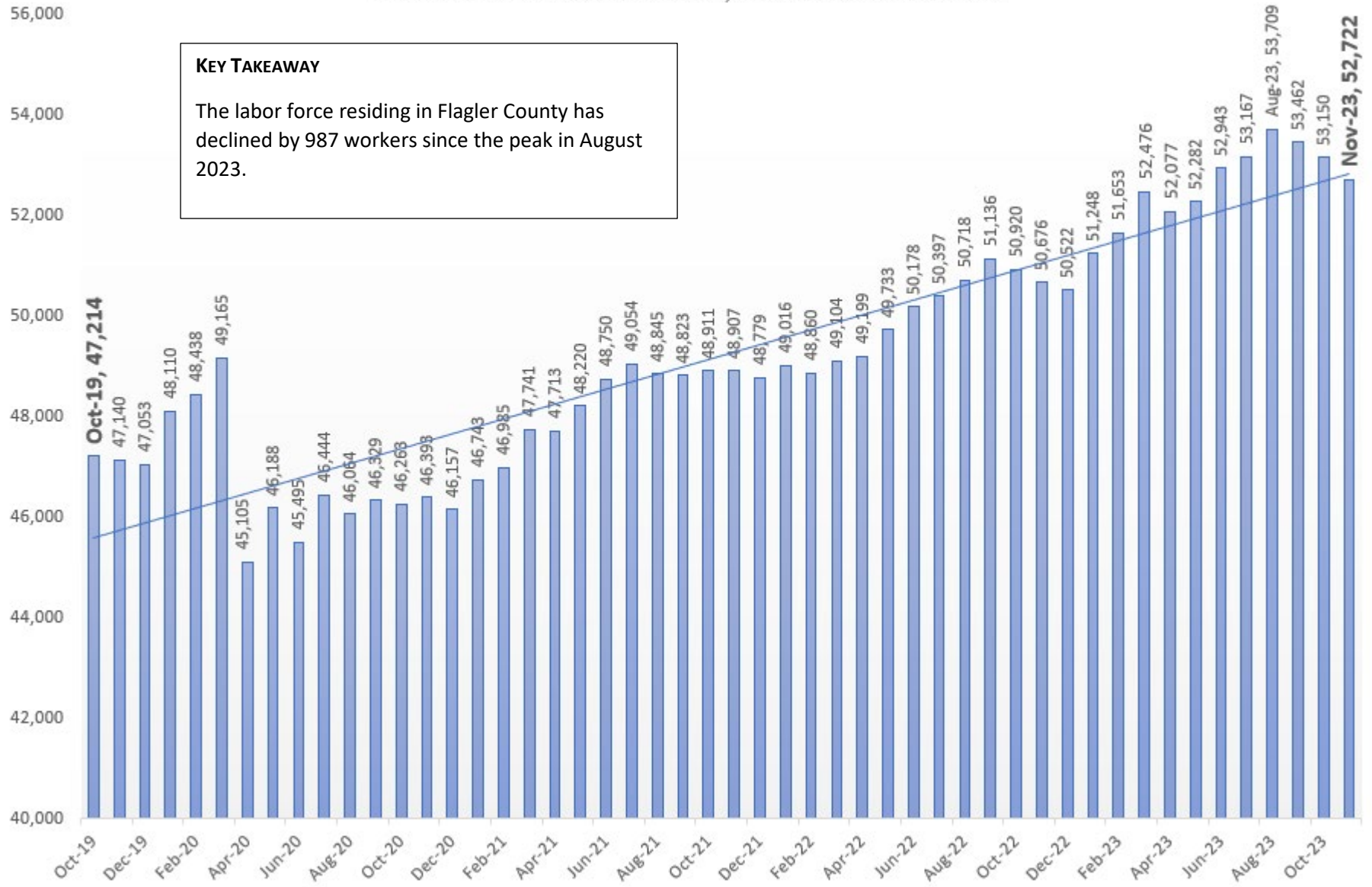

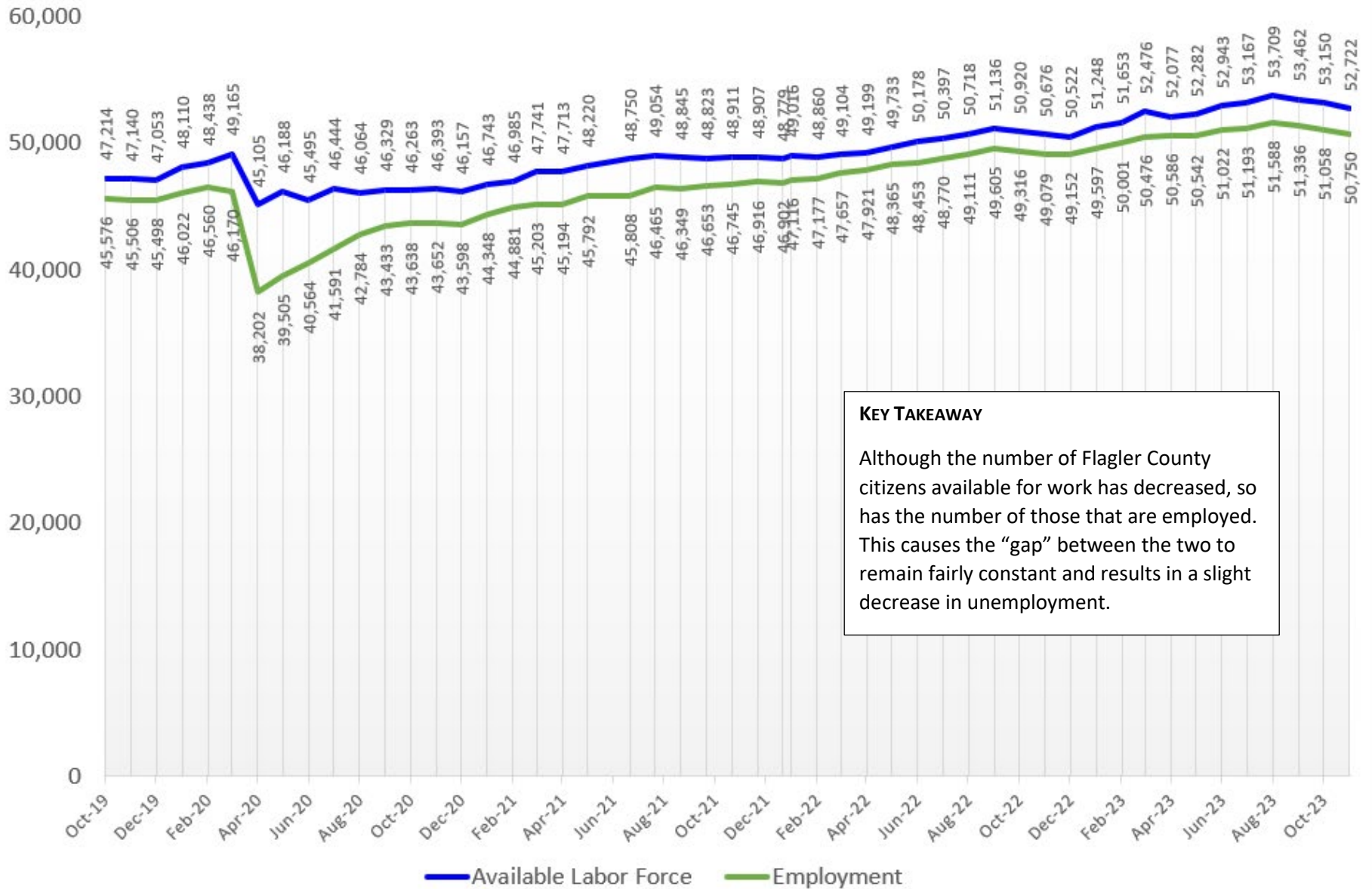

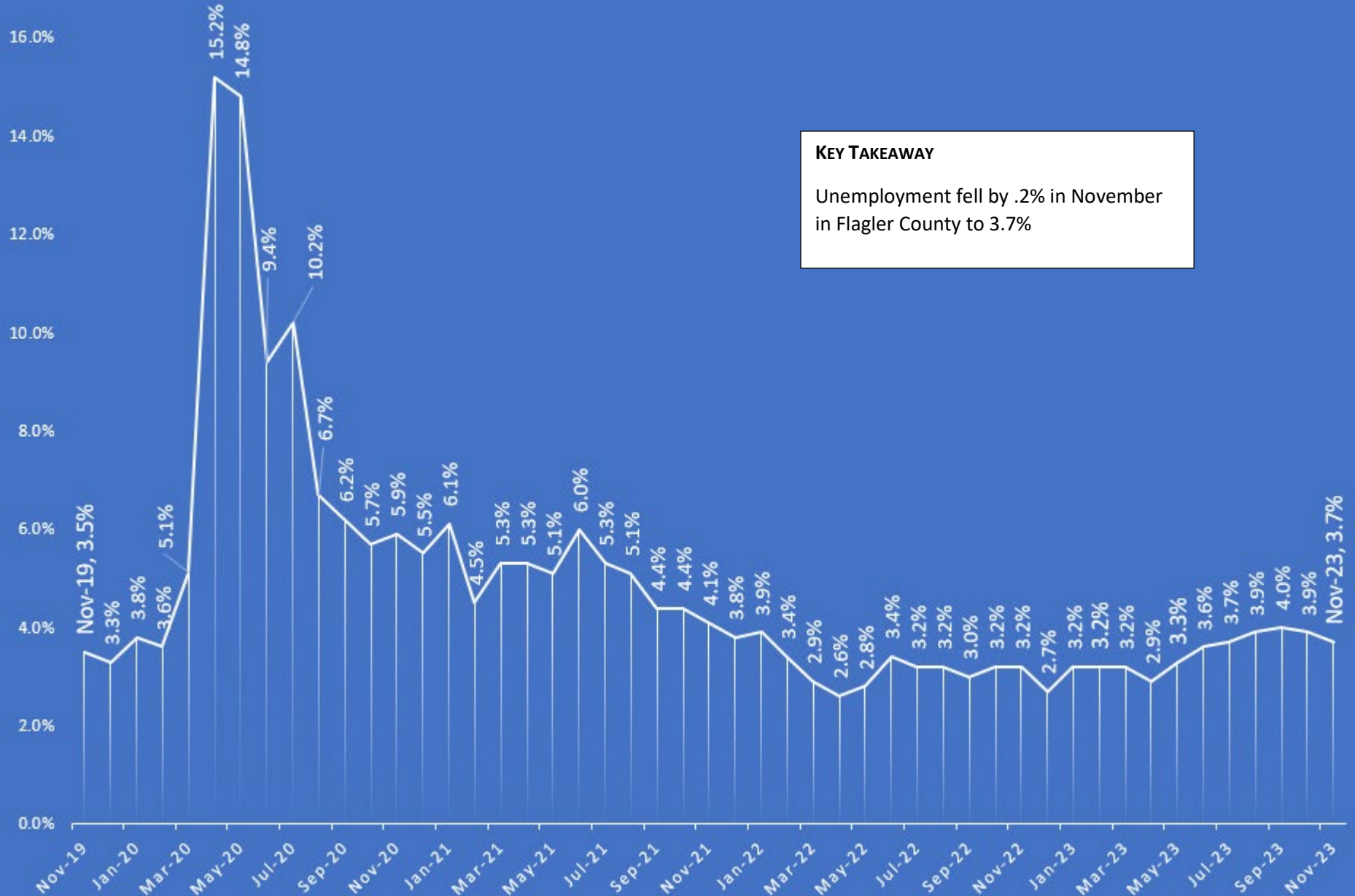


KEY TAKEAWAY

Although the number of Flagler County citizens available for work has decreased, so has the number of those that are employed. This causes the “gap” between the two to remain fairly constant and results in a slight decrease in unemployment.

UNEMPLOYMENT TREND IN FLAGLER COUNTY | NOT SEASONALLY ADJUSTED

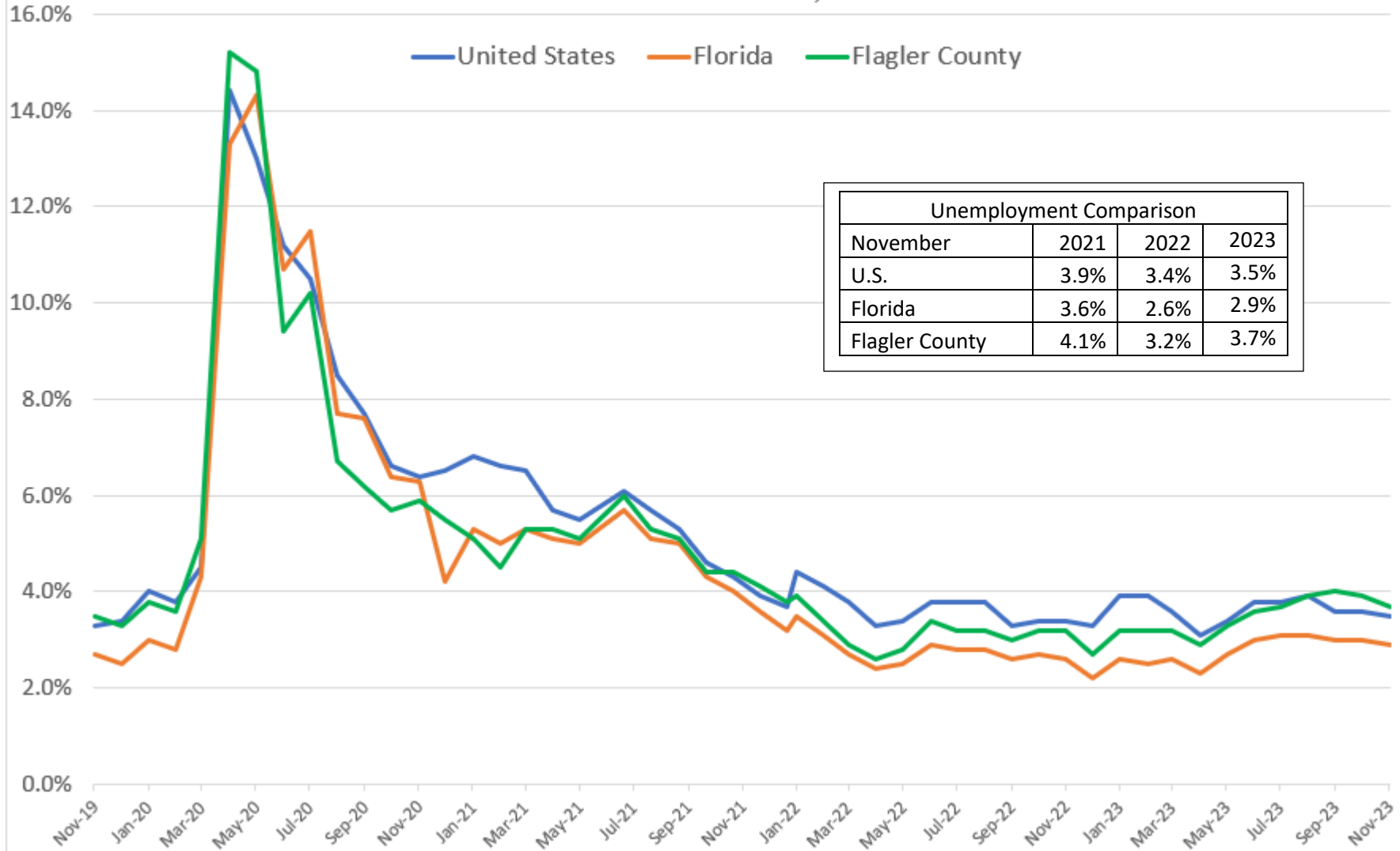
