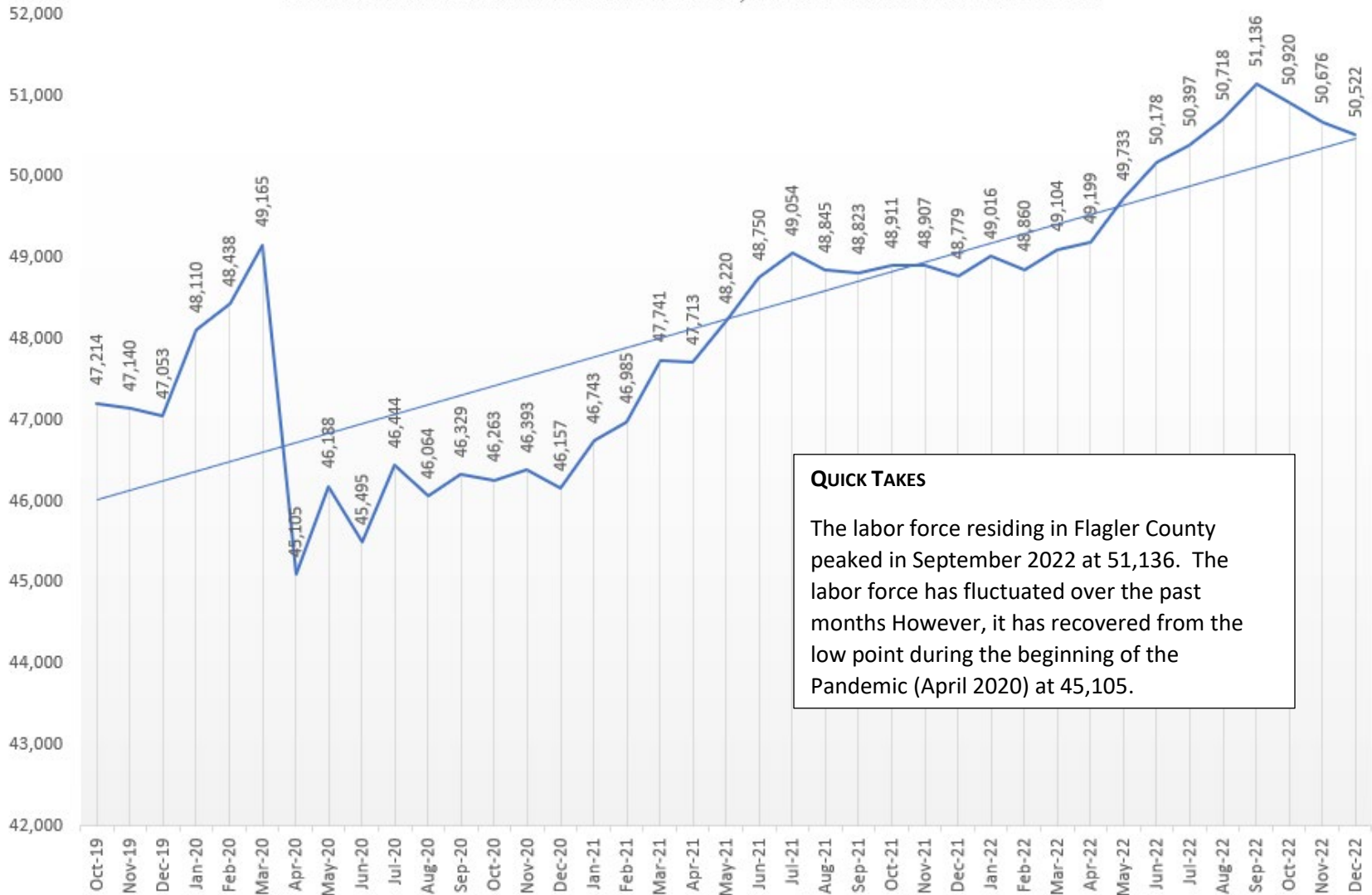

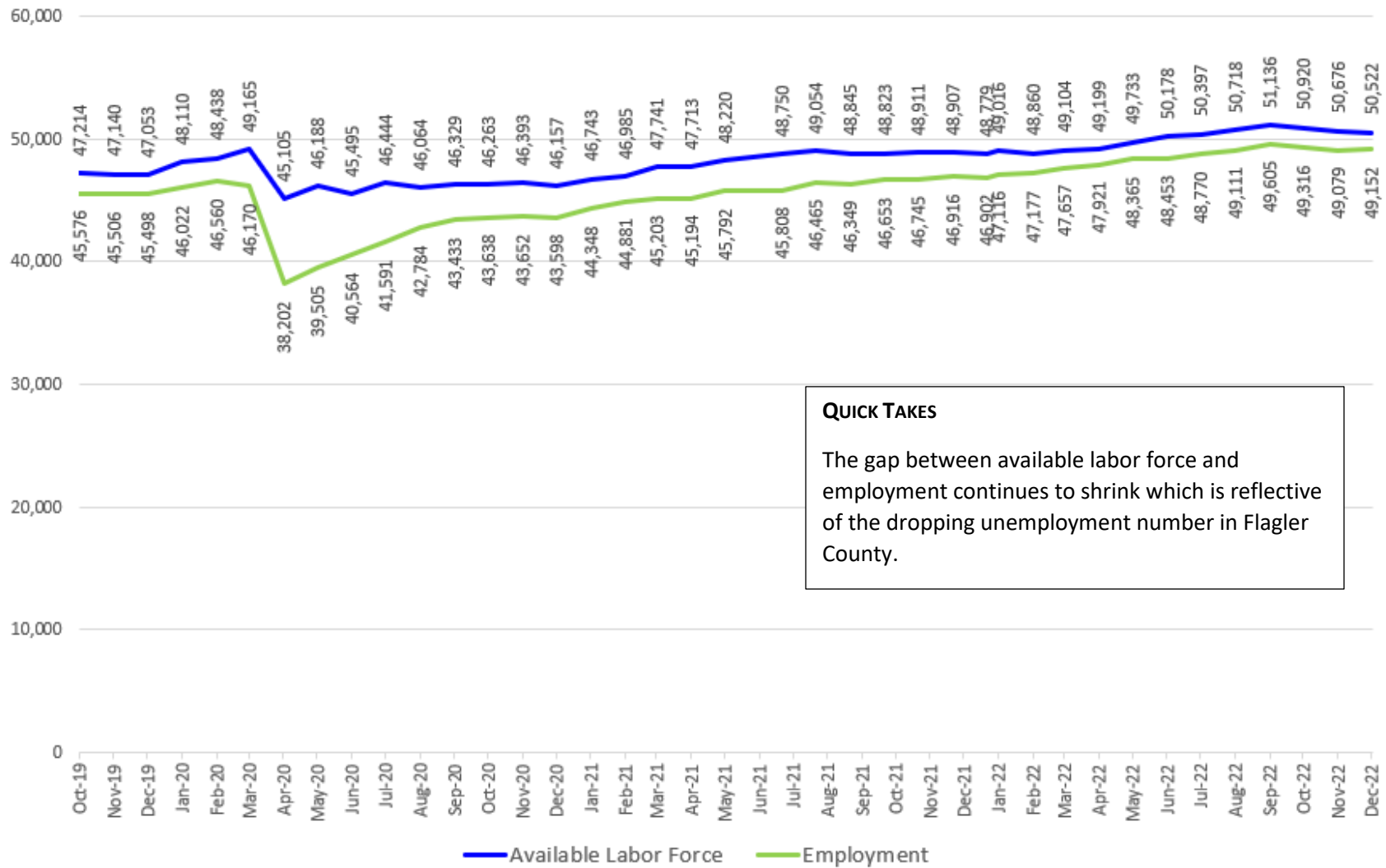


QUICK TAKES

The labor force residing in Flagler County peaked in September 2022 at 51,136. The labor force has fluctuated over the past months However, it has recovered from the low point during the beginning of the Pandemic (April 2020) at 45,105.

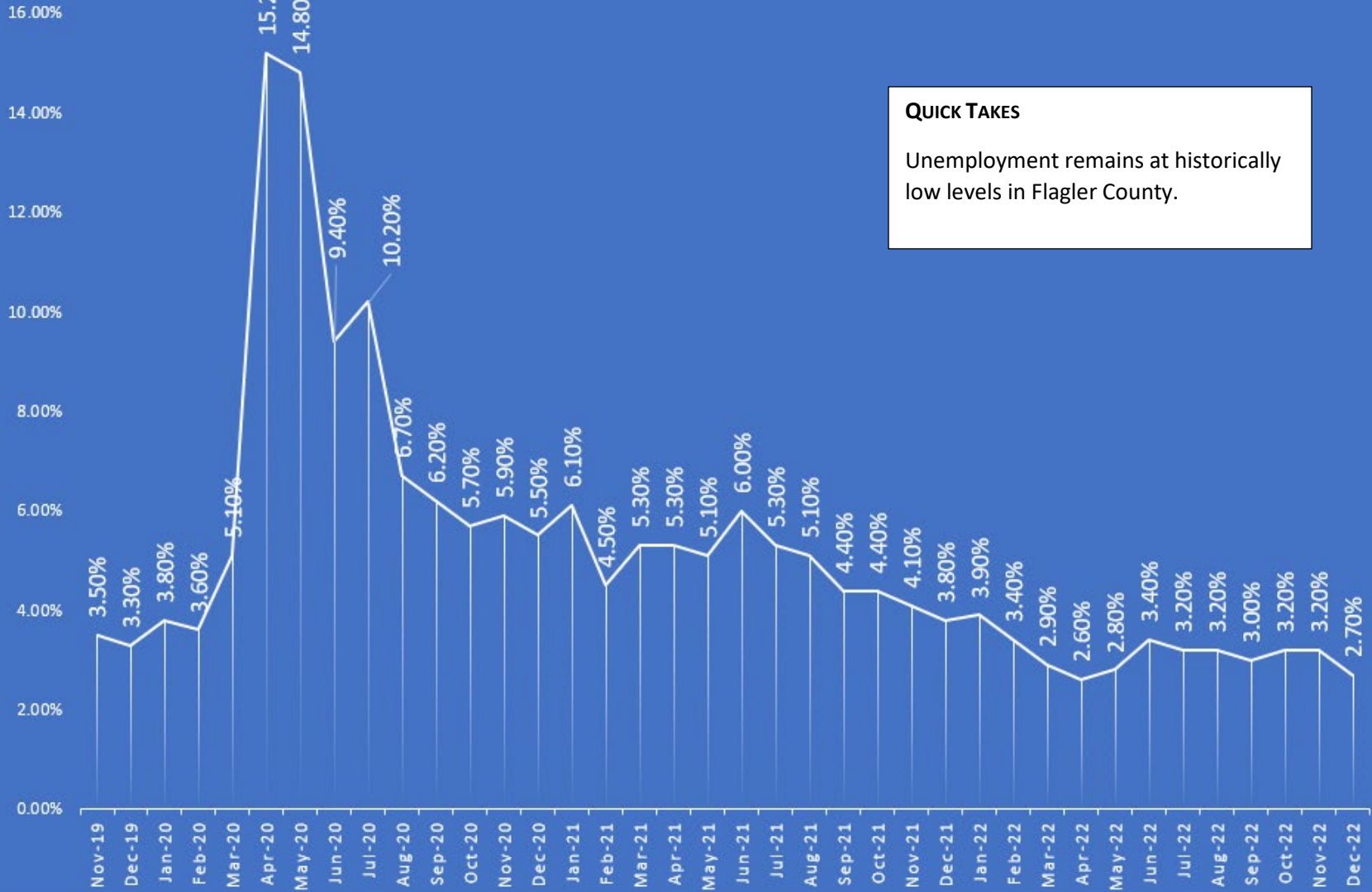


QUICK TAKES
