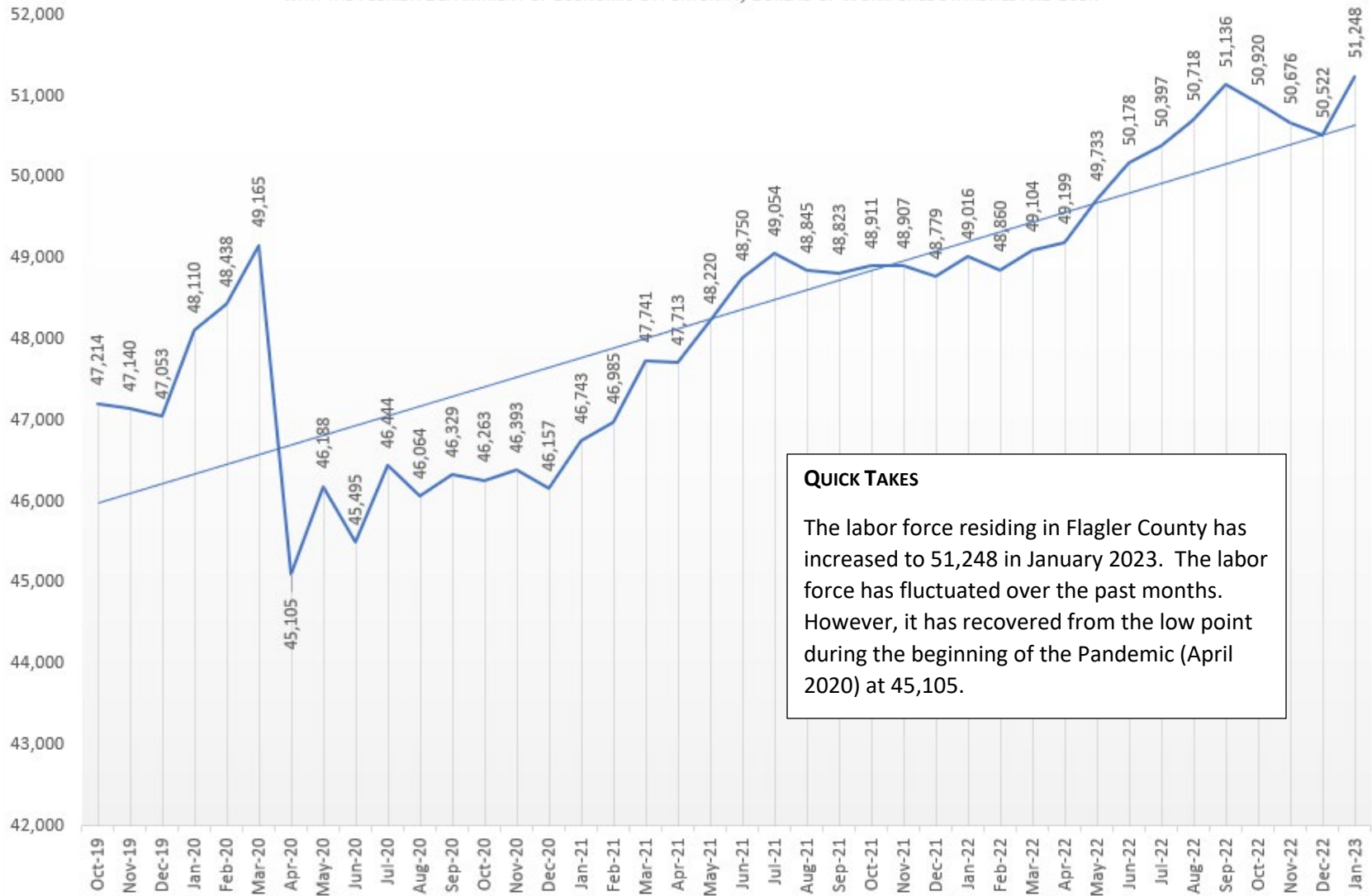

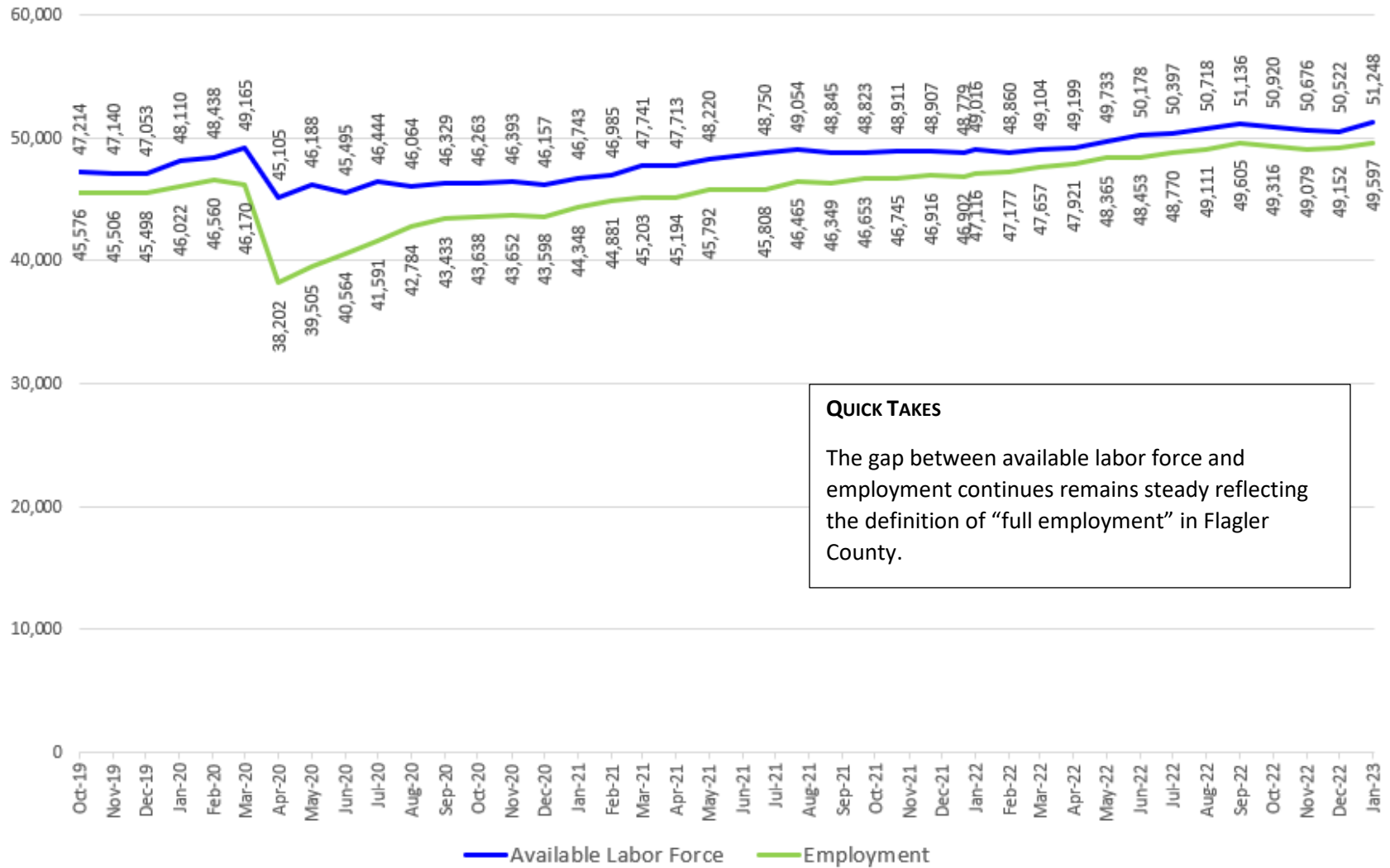


QUICK TAKES

The labor force residing in Flagler County has increased to 51,248 in January 2023. The labor force has fluctuated over the past months. However, it has recovered from the low point during the beginning of the Pandemic (April 2020) at 45,105.

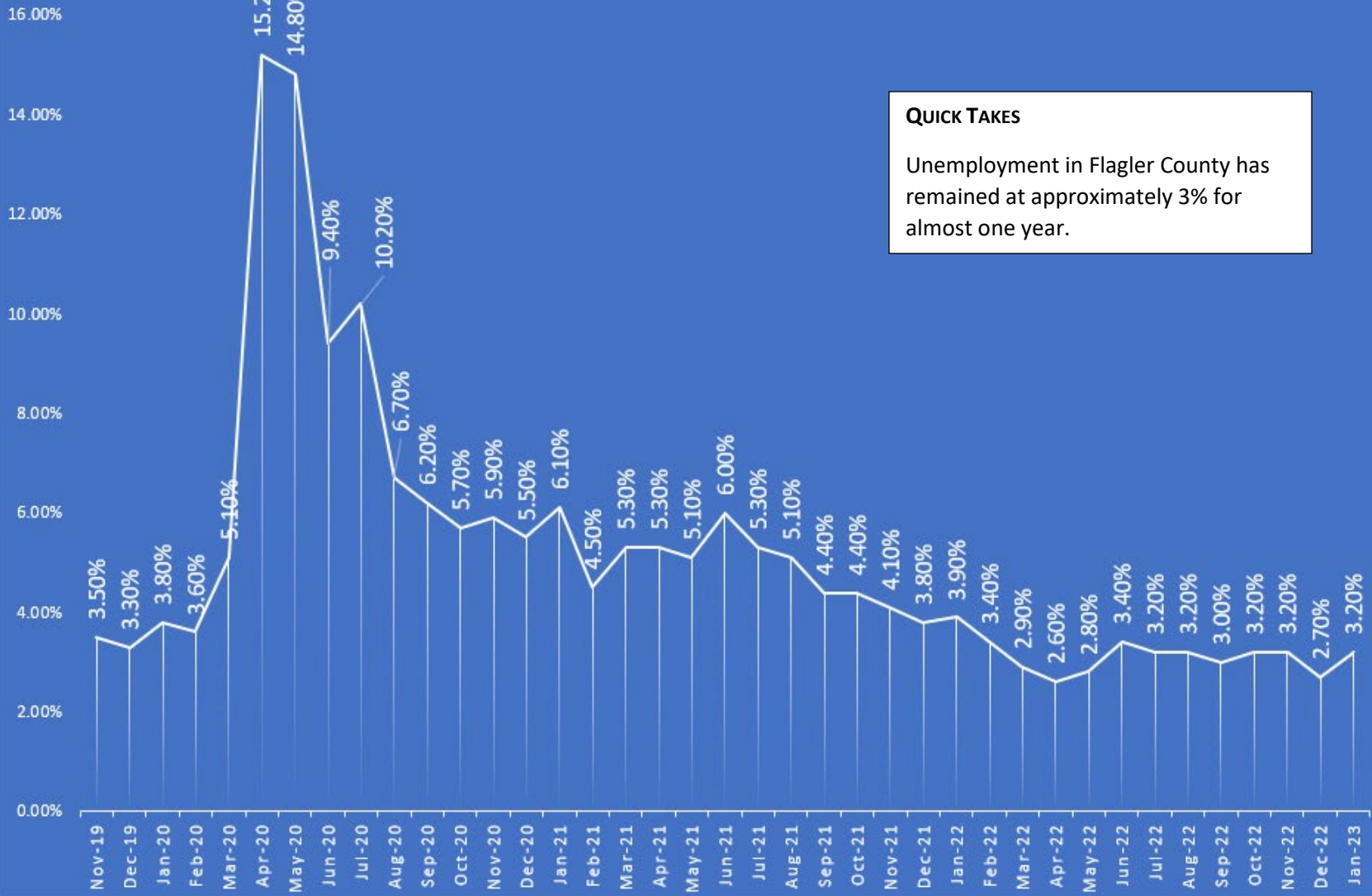


QUICK TAKES
