


**KEY TAKEAWAY**




**KEY TAKEAWAY**

Both the number of Employed Flagler County Citizens and the Number of Flagler County Citizens in the Labor Force increased at approximately the same rate. This causes the unemployment rate to remain constant from the previous month at 4.1%.




### KEY TAKEAWAY
