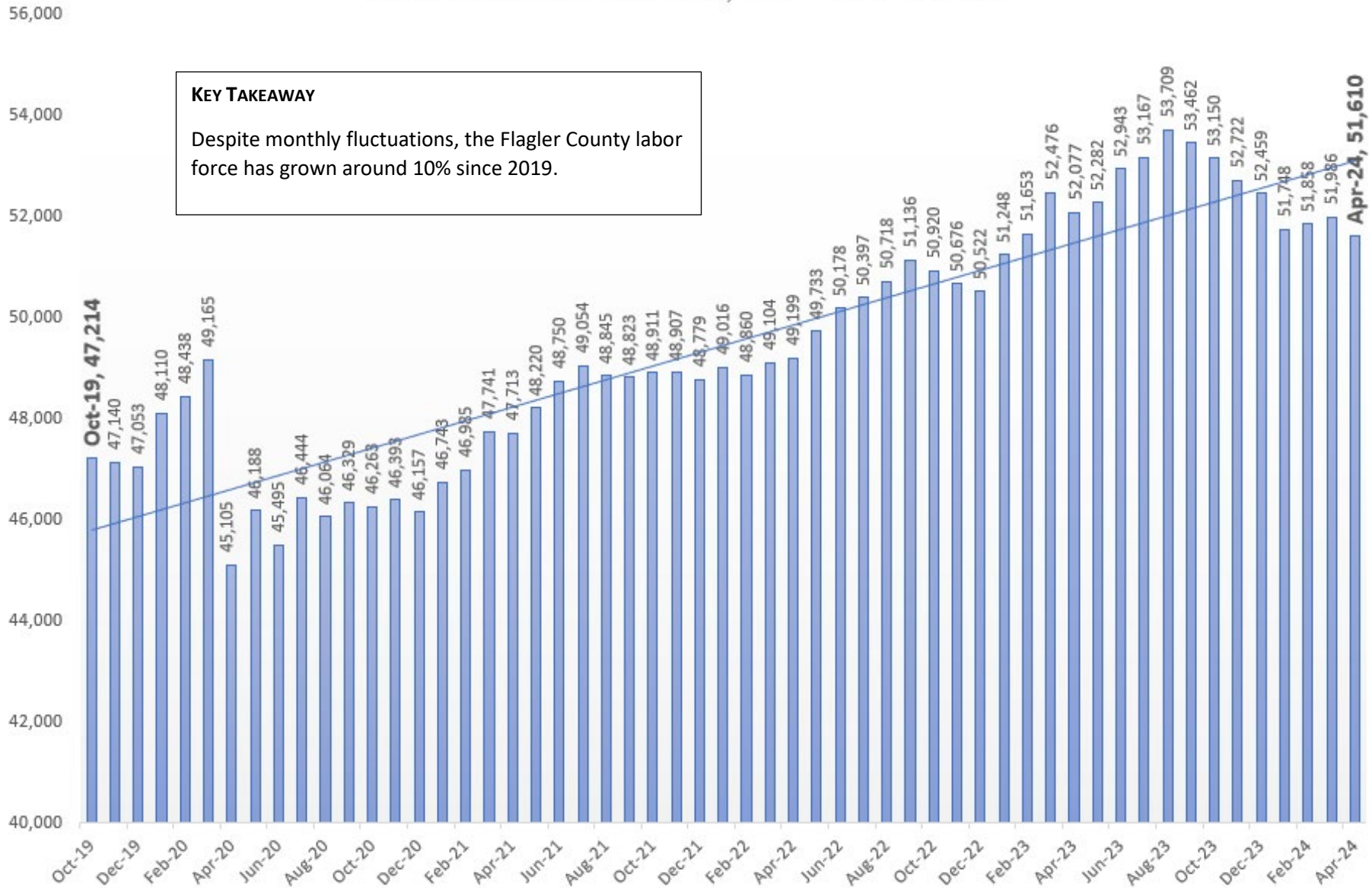

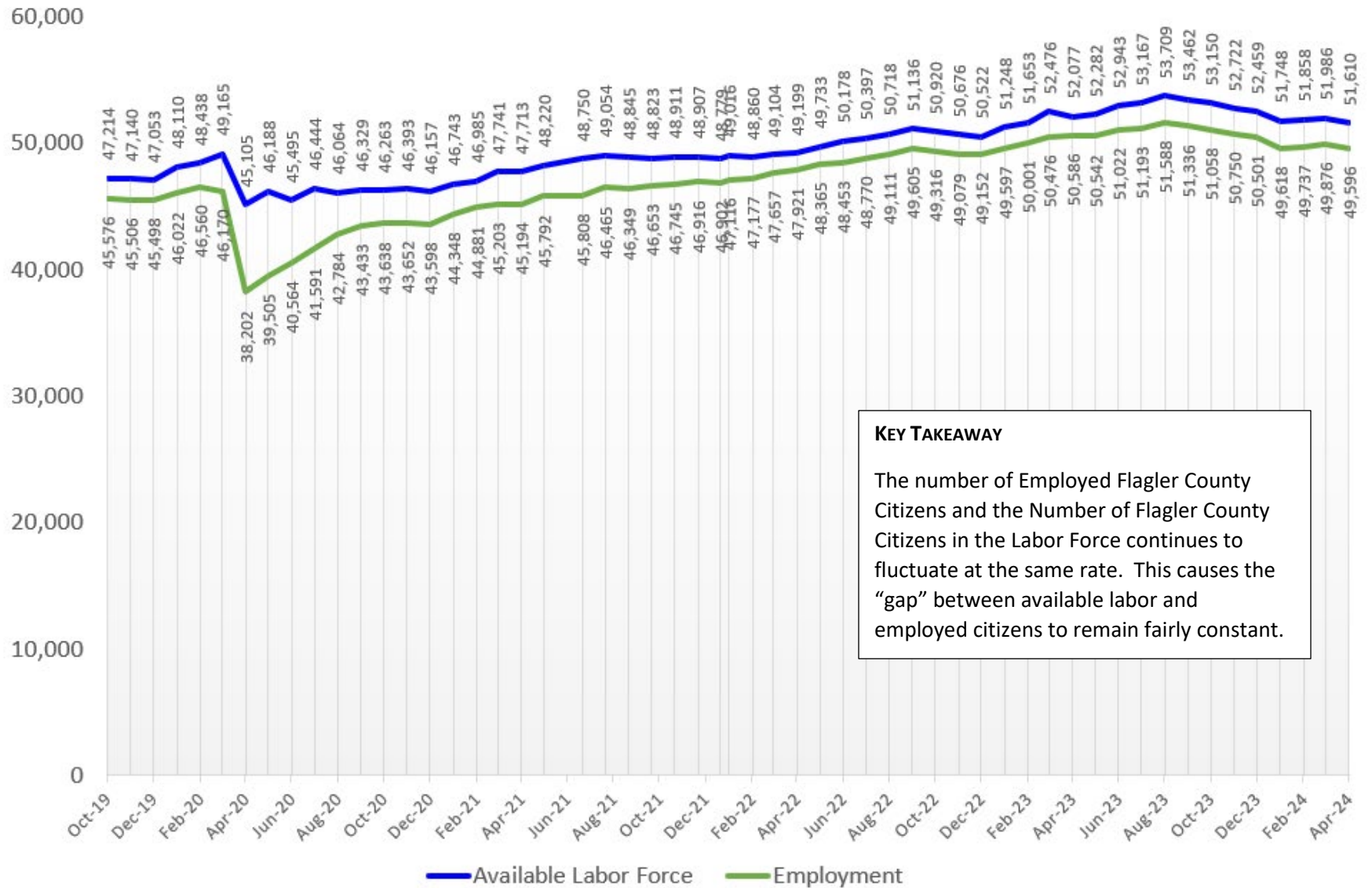
KEY TAKEAWAY

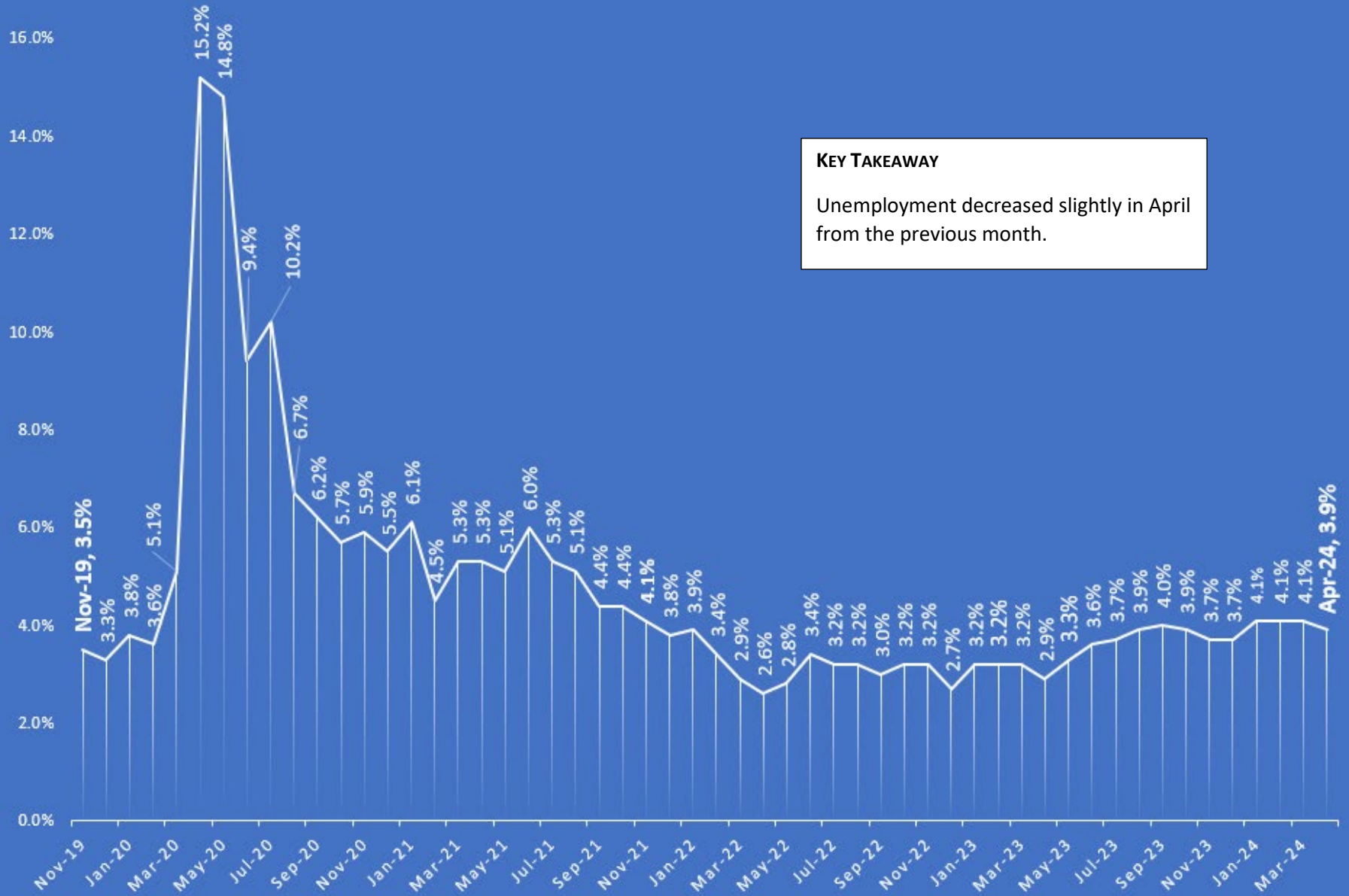


KEY TAKEAWAY

The number of Employed Flagler County Citizens and the Number of Flagler County Citizens in the Labor Force continues to fluctuate at the same rate. This causes the “gap” between available labor and employed citizens to remain fairly constant.

UNEMPLOYMENT TREND IN FLAGLER COUNTY | NOT SEASONALLY ADJUSTED

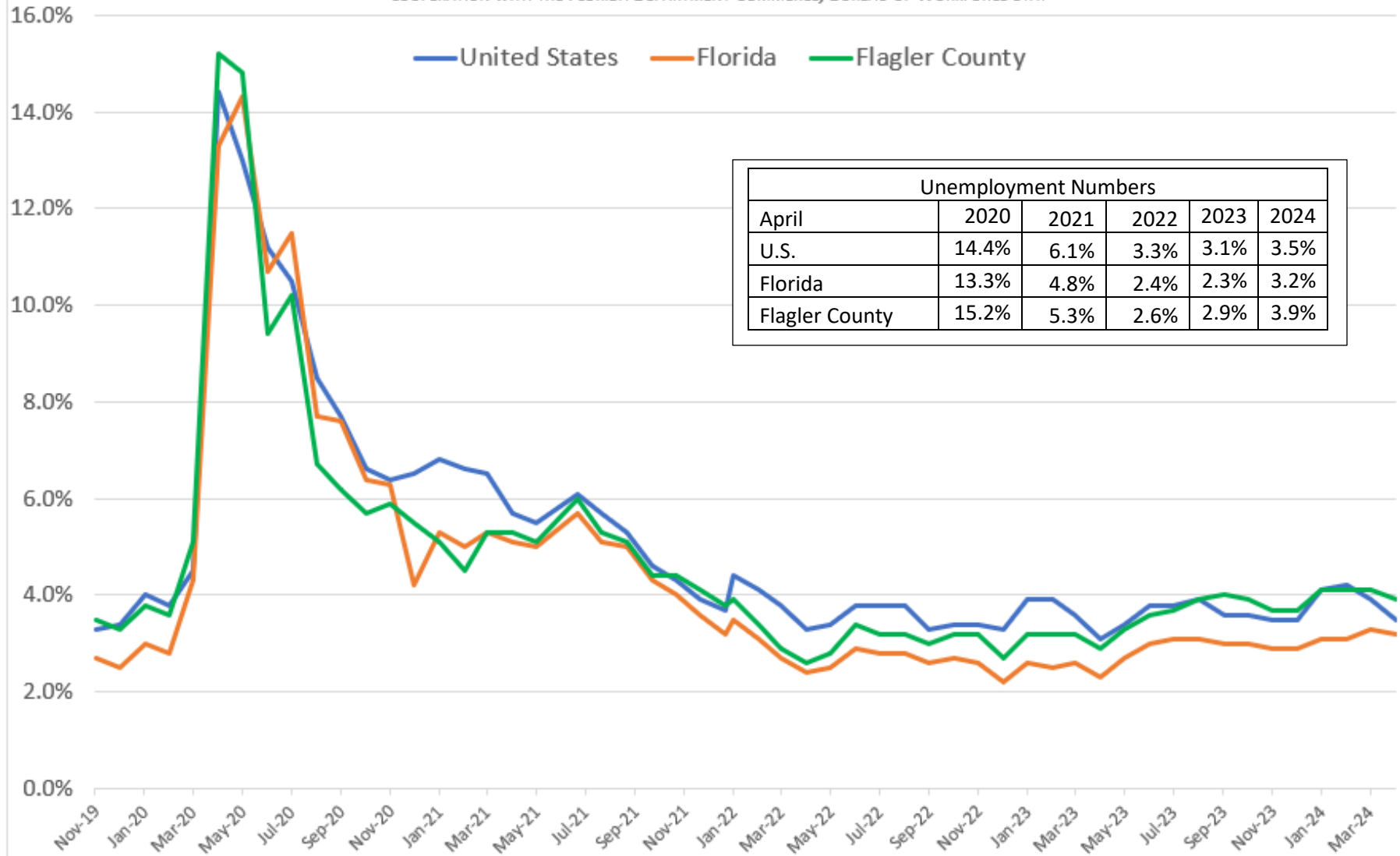
