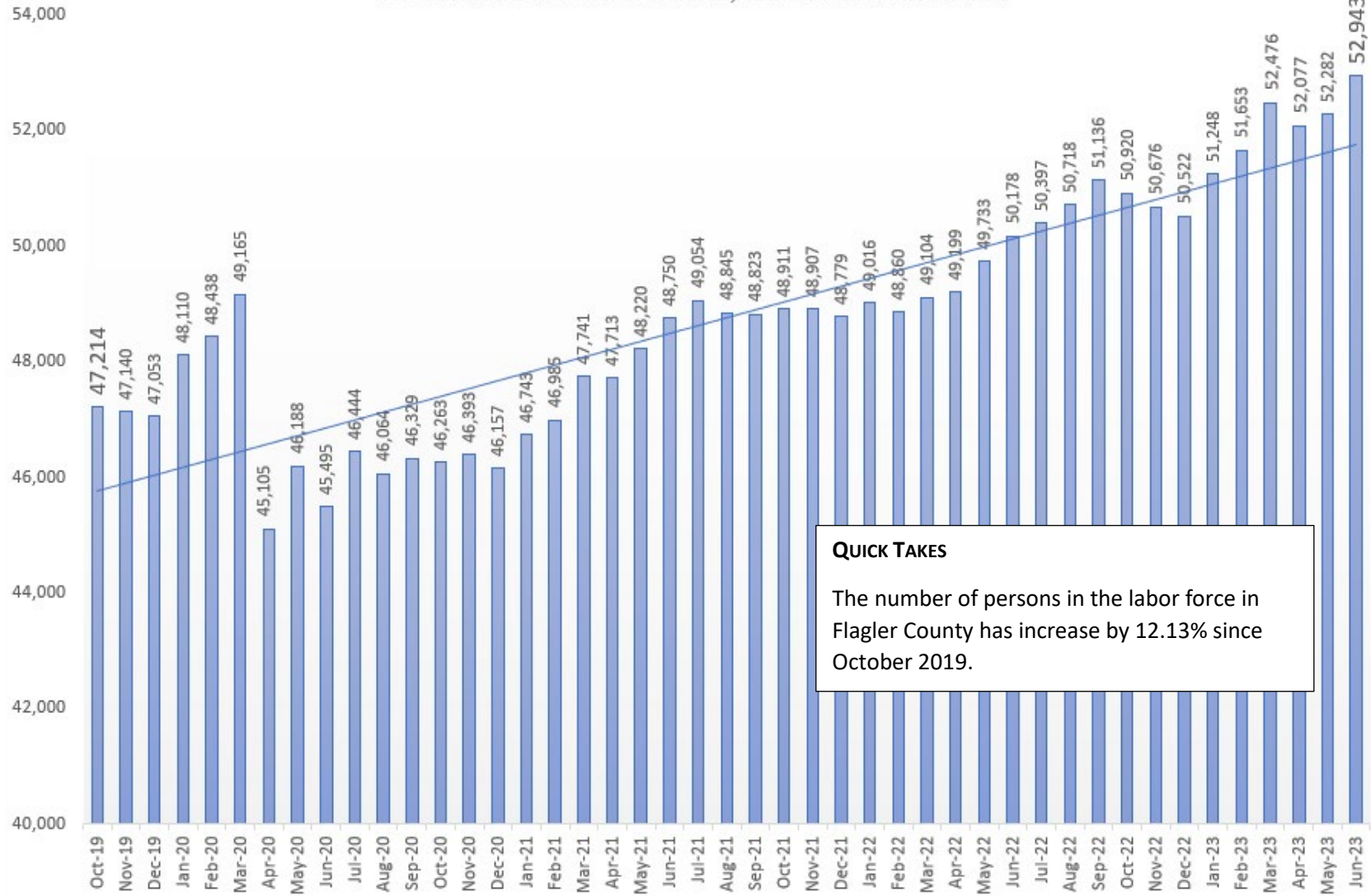

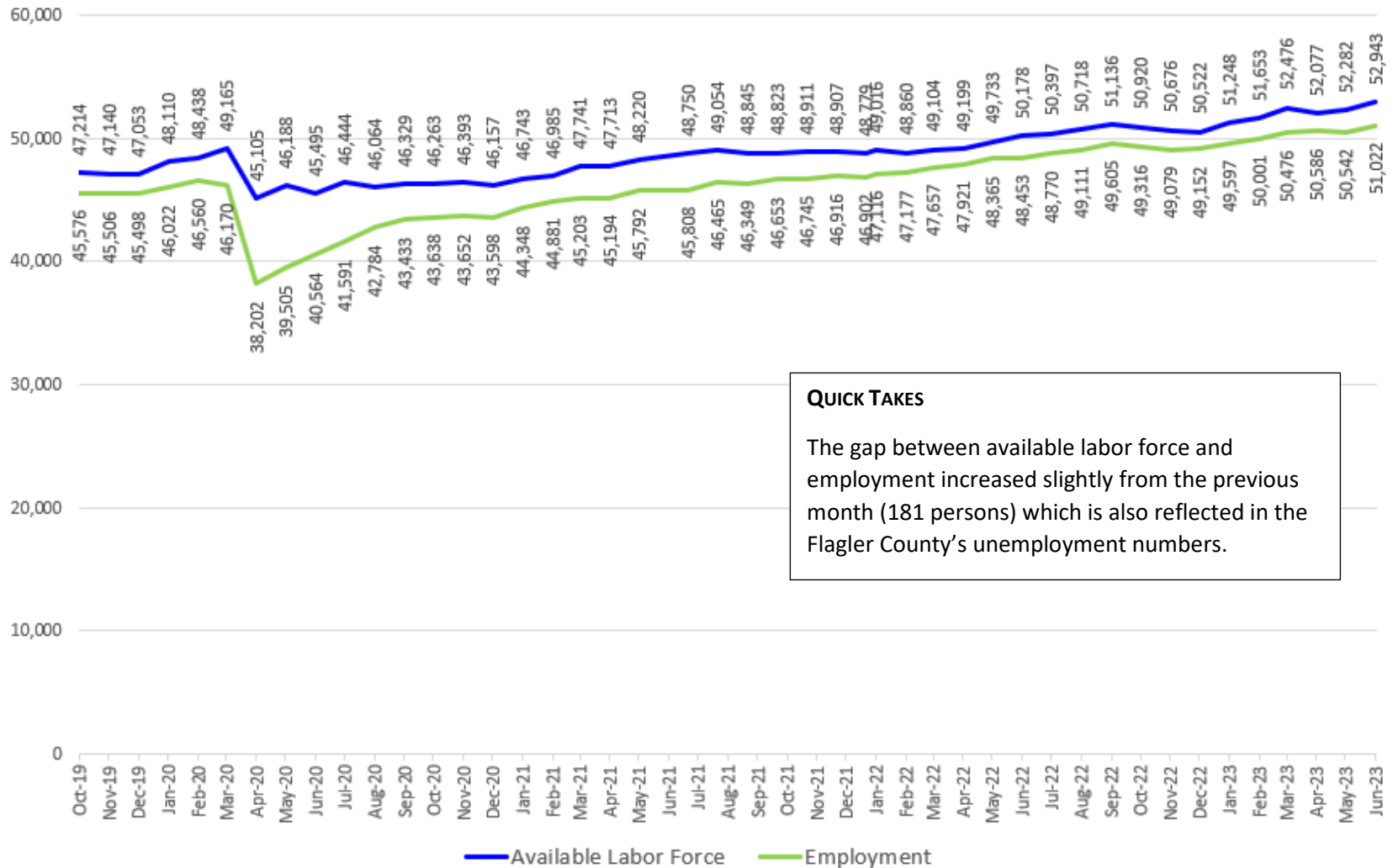


QUICK TAKES

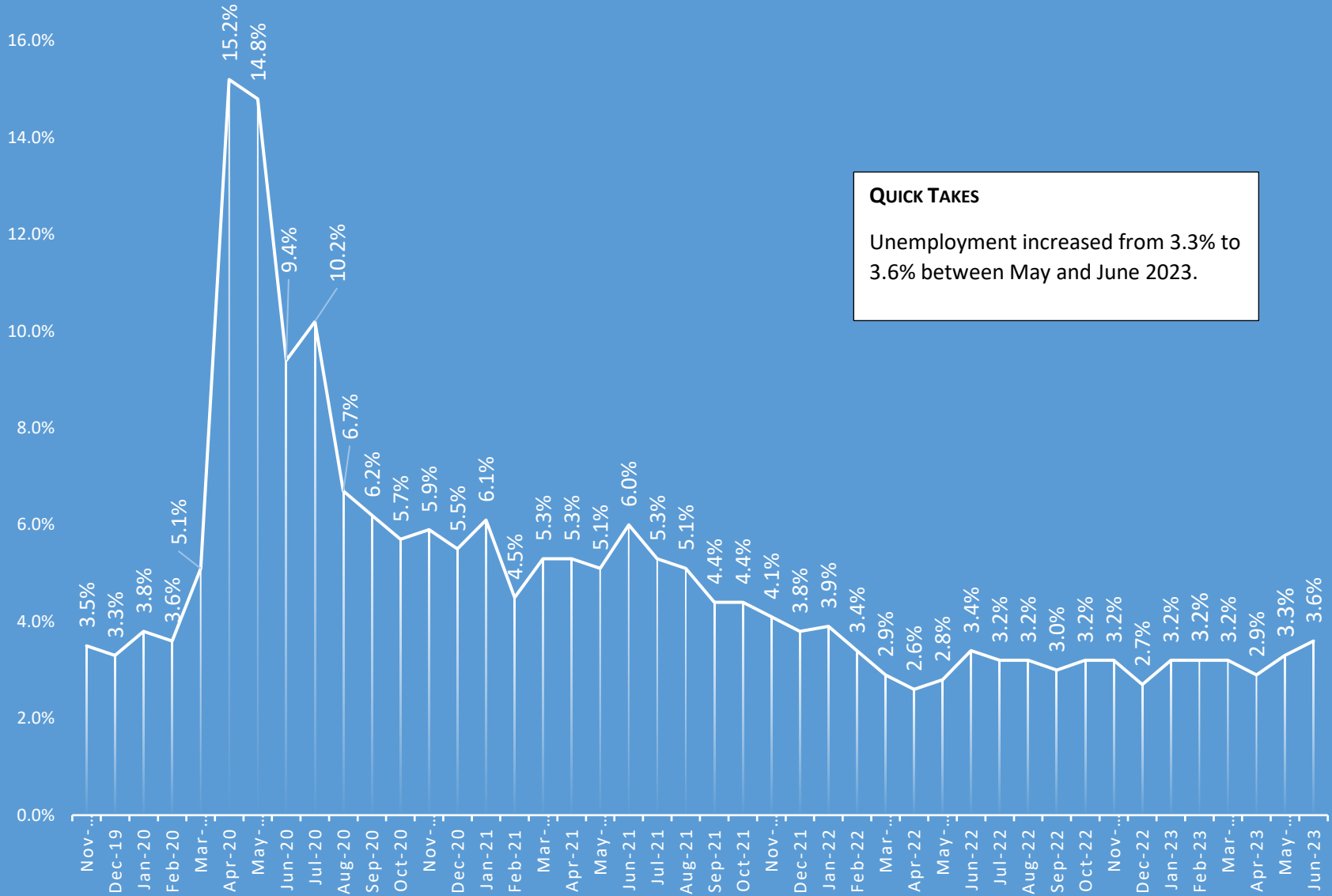
