



Located on the northeast coast of Florida,

Palm Coast and the Flagler Beaches is 31 miles south of St. Augustine and 24 miles

north of Daytona Beach, bordered on the east

How To Get Here

Palm Coast and the Flagler Beaches is only 24 miles from Interstate 4 and is approximately equal distance between the

Orlando and Jacksonville metropolitan areas.

Interstate 95, Exit 284 at State Road 100

(Bunnell and Flagler Beach) is the closest exit

to the beach from Maine to Miami

Just 3 miles!

Major airlines serve the nearby

International Airport, and Jacksonville Airport.

Private aircraft and corporate jet aircraft can

land at the Flagler County Airport off S.R. 100.
