

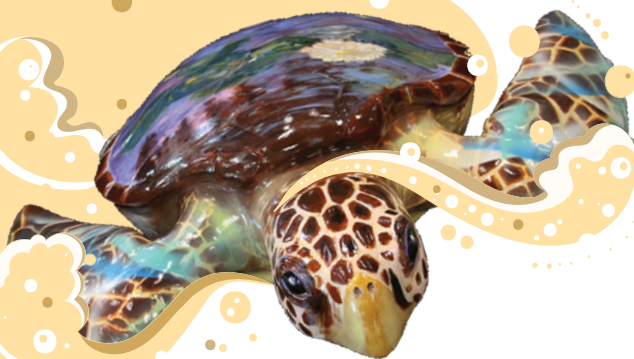

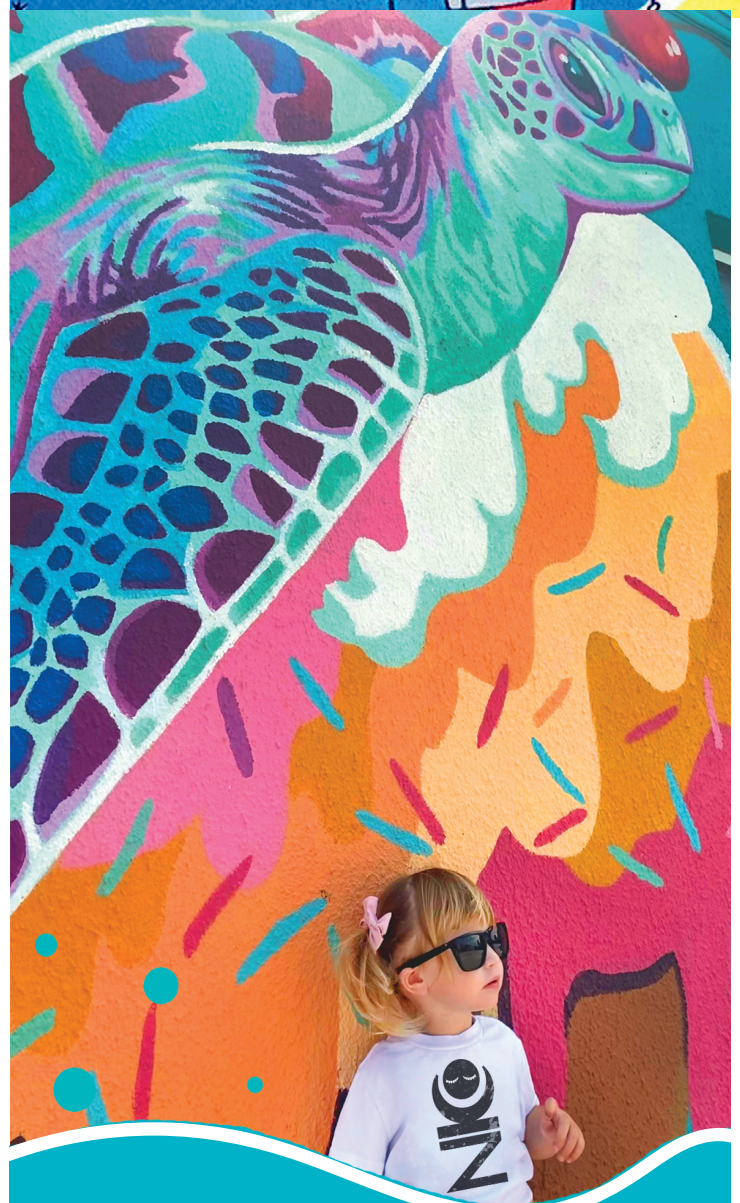
Our region's most iconic public art doubles as a scavenger hunt for the entire family to enjoy. The Palm Coast Art Foundation's Turtle Trail features more than a dozen large, fiberglass turtles each painted in their own unique way and placed in parks and other public spaces.

What began as a single turtle unveiled in 2018 is now a trail of 14 and will grow to a collection of 18 by the end of 2021.

In recent years, restaurants and cafés across Flagler Beach have partnered with local artists to splash their exteriors with murals. The stretch from North 24th Street to South 18th Street features eleven murals, including the ice cream-themed mural at Surfside Shakes, and the Insta-worthy "Raining Donuts" mural outside Swillerbees Craft Donuts and Coffee Bar. Their close proximity makes it easy to complete a mural crawl in the heart of Flagler Beach and admire art while enjoying some of our best food and drinks.

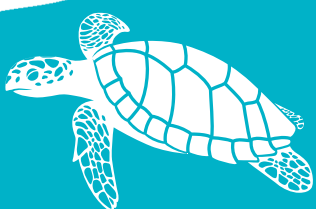

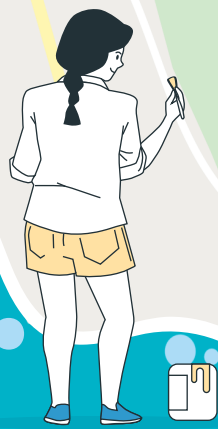
